

ROK cagers clinch Asian men's crown

RIYADH, Sept 20: South Korea won the Asian men's basketball championship in dramatic fashion, scoring four points in the final seconds to pip Japan 78-76, reports AFP.

The Koreans, who knocked out 11-time winners China in the semifinals, kept their nerve in the closing stages to claim victory in the match last night.

Japan led 44-41 at half-time and the scores remained close for the rest of the game. Korea's Moon Kyung-Eun tied the game at 76-76 in the final minute and Chun Hee-Chul, later named the tournament's Most Valuable Player, put his side ahead.

South Korea and Japan qualified for the 1998 World Championship in Athens. China, their ambitions of securing their sixth consecutive win wrecked by South Korea, looked much sharper than in their semifinal as they stormed to a 94-68 win over hosts Saudi Arabia in the third place match.
