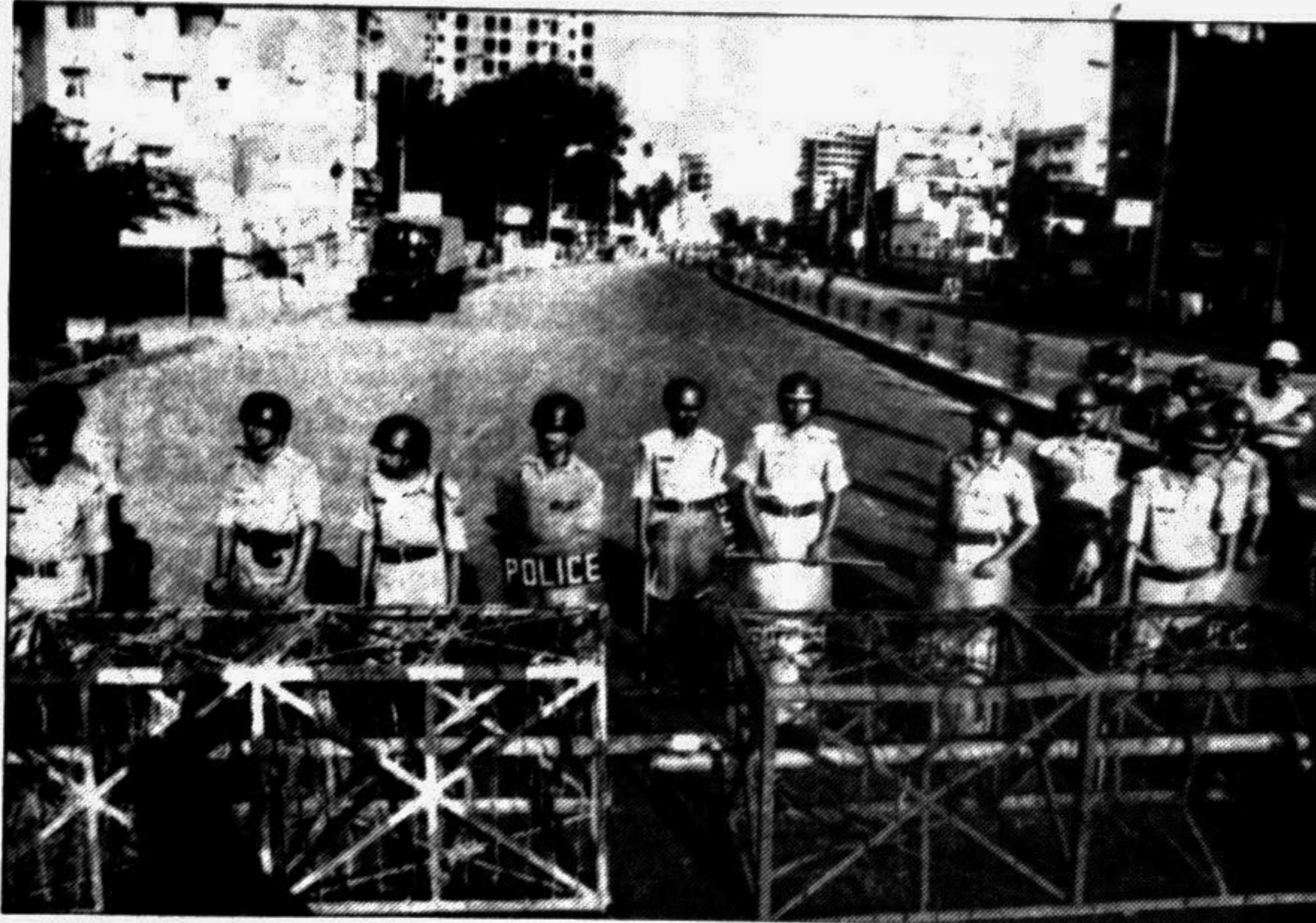

**ICDDR,B director hands over cheque to PM**  
 ICDDR,B Director Demissie Habte yesterday handed over a cheque for Tk 60,000 to fund the Bangabandhu Fellowship for Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, reports UNB.  
 The ICDDR,B offered Bangabandhu Fellowship for the meritorious students of health science in Dhaka University as part of Centre's modest contribution to strengthen research capacity in Bangladesh.  
 The scholarship is for three years and ICDDR,B completes payment of Tk 60,000 per year for the remaining two years on receipt of an annual request from Dhaka University. Habte informed the Prime Minister.  
 The award leads to a PhD for a meritorious student in Dhaka University and the research will be jointly supervised by ICDDR,B and the university.  
 The centre will offer a monthly stipend of Tk 5,000 per month for the duration of the fellowship, and also cover the cost associated with the research that the fellow will conduct as part of his requirement for a PhD degree.
