Seminar on military justice 'Army's main role is to defend constitution'

The Second US-Bangladesh Military Justice seminar began at the Armed Forces Medical Institute auditorium at Dhaka Cantonment yesterday, reports UNB.

Attorney General Barrister KS Nabi was the chief guest at the inaugural function of the five-day seminar, jointly sponsored by Bangladesh and the US Armed Forces.

In his brief speech, the Attorney General said that one of the main roles of the Armed Forces was to defend the constitution of the country.

The members of the Armed Forces, should, therefore, continue to contribute towards the government's efforts for ensuring the rule of law and upholding the democratic institutions of the country, he added.

Deputy Chief of the US Embassy in Dhaka Ted Nist, chief host and Director of Military Training (AHQ) Brig Muhammad Masudur Rahman, and US delegation leader Capt Dean Michael Hinkley also spoke at the opening session, said an ISPR press release.

The seminar, second of its kind in Bangladesh, will have a far reaching effect in promoting better understanding of military legal system by civil polity of both the countries and reaping the benefit out of it.

It embraces topics like administration separations, military justice, appeals processes and development of a uniform code of military justice.

Participants in the seminar are representatives from the Armed Forces Division, ministries of Defence and Law, Bangladesh Army, Navy and Air Force, BDR, Police, Ansar and VDP, Dhaka University's Faculty of Law, Office of the Attorney General, Judicial Administration Training Institute, Bangladesh Bar Council, ISPR Directorate, Bangladesh Red Crescent Society, Bangladesh Institute of Democratic Rights, the US Embassy in Dhaka, delegates from the Iranian envoy calls on PM

Iranian Ambassador in Bangladesh Mohammed Sadeq Fayyaz called on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her office yesterday and discussed matters of mutual interest of the two countries, reports UNB.

Enhancing trade and commerce between Dhaka and Tehran got prominence in the discussion.

Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister Dr SA Samad and newly appointed foreign secretary Mustafizur Rahman were present on the occasion.

Meanwhile, Neuro Surgeon of Singapore Mount Elizabeth Hospital Dr Gopal Barathion called on Prime Minister Hasina at her office yesterday.

Dr Barathion arrived in the city for the treatment of ailing Nurunnahar Samad, wife of Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad.

Mrs Samad is undergoing treatment in critical condition at the BIRDEM Hospital.

Condition of Begum Samad still critical

The condition of Begum Nurunnahar Samad, wife of Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad, now being treated at BIRDEM hospital remained unchanged yesterday, reports BSS.

The medical team constituted for her treatment yesterday examined Begum Samad and reviewed the process of treatment, a PID handout said.

Ambassadors of a number of countries visited the patient at the hospital yesterday.

Meanwhile, US Assistant Secretary of State for South Asian Affairs Karl F Indurfarth and Secretary General of SAARC Naeem U Hassan, in separate messages to the Foreign Minister, wished early recovery of Begum Samad.
