People urged to foil conspiracy against govt

Various organisations yesterday strongly condemned the destructive politics of a section of the opposition parties in the name of democratic rights and urged the people to foil conspiracy against an elected government, reports BSS.

In a statement, Bangladesh Krishak League president and State Minister for Land Alhaj Rashed Mosharraf said, the present activities of the BNP under Begum Khaleda Zia remind the people of their old tactics of destabilising the country. He alleged that the BNP leader Begum Zia was giving direct provocations for acts of terrorism, arson and conspiracy when the country is marching ahead under the leadership of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

The Krishak League leader called upon the people to build up a strong resistance against the anarchic political culture of the BNP. He said this party is not only creating road obstacles and damaging vehicles but also became envious of the success of the government in various sectors.

Meanwhile, a protest meeting was organised by the Sonali Bank Employees Union against the terrorist activities damage of vehicles, arson and other anti-democratic activities - by a section of the opposition parties.

The meeting was addressed among others, by union's vice president Sultan Ahmed and Sonali Bank CBA general secretary Jamaluddin Ahmed, Mesbahuddin Ahmed, KM Azam Khasru, Nazimuddin, Kamaluddin, Abdul Jabbar Sikder and Nurul Alam.

Speakers at the rally said that the BNP was again hatching conspiracy to destabilise the country. They urged the Mujib followers to keep vigilance against them.

South African parliamentary team due Saturday

An eight-member parliamentary delegation from South Africa will arrive in the city Saturday on a three-day visit to Bangladesh, reports BSS.

Ms B M Ntuli MP will lead the delegation.

The visit is aimed at strengthening relations between the parliaments of Bangladesh and South Africa through exchange of views, official sources said.

The delegation members during their stay here will study the working of small and medium type enterprises in Bangladesh in order to see how the Bangladesh model could be adopted in South Africa.

The delegation members will also visit some medium and small industries, export processing zone and a few NGOs including BRAC and Grameen Bank, sources added.

The delegation, first from South Africa is likely to call on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, Speaker of the Jatiya Sangsad, Minister for Commerce and Industries and other government leaders.

DU clarification

Dhaka University authorities yesterday denied reports carried by a section of the press that the office of the vice-chancellor was searched for a student leader 'Sunday', reports BSS.

A press release of the university giving clarification of the development said, some students at about 1 pm Sunday went to the administrative building office of the vice-chancellor to inform him that a student leader allegedly involved in the killing of Tanal had taken shelter in the building. They appealed him (VC) to take necessary steps to hand over the student leader to police.

The vice-chancellor then asked the Proctor to search the council room and its adjoining rooms along with the police personnel on duty. They conducted the search accordingly but did not find him, the press release said.

Later some students told the vice-chancellor that law and order situation of the university would deteriorate if the person allegedly involved in the killing returned to the campus. They demanded cancellation of his admission.

The vice-chancellor told them that he knew nothing about the admission and examination of the student leader. He said if there were any specific charges against him law enforcing agencies would take necessary steps.

No incident of hurling abuses to the VC or searching his office took place, the press release asserted adding such reports in the press can create confusion in the mind of public.

PM condoles death of Luxmipur AL leader

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has expressed profound shock at the death of founder president of Luxmipur district Awami League advocate Akteruzzaman on Saturday night. He was 75, reports UNB.

In a condolence message yesterday, the Prime Minister recalled the contributions of valiant freedom fighter Akteruzzaman in the Liberation War and his courageous role during the country's democratic movements.

Sheikh Hasina said the elderly politician will be ever remembered for his selfless contributions for the wellbeing of common people.

Obituary

Veteran trade union leader M S Huq died on Sunday at Chittagong due to old-age complications, a press release said yesterday. He was 81, reports BSS.

He was the president of Bangladesh Rail Sramik Union and vice president of Trade Union Centre (TUC).

Dewan Mohammad Ali and Abdus Sabur working president and general secretary respectively of Bangladesh Rail Sramik Union have condoled the death of Huq and prayed for the peace of his departed soul and expressed deep sympathy to the members of the bereaved family.

Regional meeting on tourism training opens in Tehran

A regional meeting on 'establishment of network of tourism training institutes and organisation' sponsored jointly by Ministry of Culture and Islamic Guidance of Iran and UN-ESCAP opened in Tehran yesterday, Iranian Embassy press release said, reports BSS.

About 25 countries of Asia Pacific region including ESCAP, WTO and other relevant organisations participated in the meeting.

Bangladesh at the conference, was represented by Mohammad Ismail Hossain, secretary, Ministry of Civil Aviation and Tourism and Shafiqul Bari, principal, National Hotel and Tourism Training Institute.

Other participating countries are Australia, Azerbaijan, China, Fiji, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Iran, Meca, Malaysia, the Maldives, Mongolia, Myanmar, Pakistan, the Philippines, Korea, Singapore, Sri Lanka and Thailand.

Plea to make agriculture edn compulsory at secondary level

Bangladesh Government Secondary Teachers' Association (Agriculture) appealed to the government for early fulfillment of five-point demand including compulsory agricultural education at the secondary school level, reports BSS.

Addressing a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club Saturday the teachers of agricultural institutions claimed that the National Curriculum and Text Book Board has made the agricultural education optional this year instead of a compulsory subject from class six to ten.

They said that the decision will severely hamper the development of the country's agriculture sector in future as most of the secondary school level students cannot go for higher education and will remain in the villages with their livelihood on agriculture.
