CHTDB executing Tk 110cr development projects

CHITTAGONG, Sept 23: Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) has been witnessing an era of development with six special development projects being executed in the region with an estimated cost of Taka 110 crore by Chittagong Hill Tracts Development Board (CHTDB) in collaboration with UNICEF and other agencies.

CHTDB sources told BSS, that the projects, taken in 1993 and to be completed by the year 2000 have been designed with the main objective to improving the socio-economic conditions of people of the regions through ensuring basic services like health, education, sanitation, safe water, income generating project and development of communication networks.

Of the six special projects, a Taka 34.4 crore multi-sectoral community development project is being implemented in 25 thanas of Rangamati, Bandarban and Khagrachhari districts to ensure basic services to some five lakh tribal families in the hilly remote areas.

The first phase of the project, which began in January 1996, has already been completed and its second phase is progressing fast, the sources said.

The second phase of upland settlement project for the rehabilitation of some 1000 tribals and non-tribal families with a cost of Taka 29.32 crore began in January 1993 in Bandarban and Khagrachhari districts, is also progressing fast, the sources said.
