Efforts on to curb terrorism

FENI, Sept 24: A bid to abduct a college girl was foiled by the local people in Sadar thana on Sunday, reports UNB.

Witnesses said a gang of miscreants tried to abduct Khaleda Akhtar, 18, 1st year student of Fazlpur Southeast College, at about 1 pm while she was returning home from the college. But on hearing the hue and cry local people rushed to the spot and the kidnappers fled the scene leaving behind the girl.

2 youths electrocuted

MADARIPUR, Sept 24: Two youths were electrocuted while fishing in a ditch in Kalkini thana of the district, police said, reports UNB.

The victims were identified as Motahar Akand, 25, and Yakub Ali, 24, of Dhamusa village of the thana. Police said the victims met the tragic end on Tuesday when they came in contact with a live electric wire that was thrown into the ditch by some local youths after enjoying VDO shows at a nearby field. They took connection from the mainline illegally.

Reception to educationist

BARISAL, Sept 24: A reception was accorded to renowned educationist Prof Md Hanif, now Principal of the Islamia College and ex-Principal of the Government Brojomohun University College for his selection as a member of the academic council of the National University on September 16, reports BSS.

The reception was given by the teachers and employees of Islamia College. The speakers of the reception hailed this selection terming it as a proper and just decision. Presided over by Prof Mohsin-ul-Islam Habul, the reception was also attended, among others by Prof Khaleda Fancy Khan, Shahjahan Mia and others.

Plan to open computer course in colleges

TANGAIL, Sept 24: The government has taken up a programme to open computer course at HSC level in 136 government colleges of the country, reports BSS.

According to relevant authority, 25 colleges have been selected in the first phase under this programme. Each of these colleges has been provided with five computer sets and accessories. Government Maulana Mohammad Ali College is one of the recipients of the computers under this programme. Computer course in the selected colleges is expected to start in the current session.

New bus terminal opens in Sherpur

SHERPUR, Sept 24: Education Minister ASHK Saadek has said the government believes in extensive and balanced development of all areas of the country, reports UNB.

The present government will not behave step-motherly to the innocent people like the previous governments. It believes in development even in the areas where Awami League candidates were not elected, said the minister while inaugurating a new bus terminal in Sherpur Paurashava on Saturday. Saadek said Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, daughter of the father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, came to power to render services to the people, not to establish party rule.

Panic grips Ukhiya-Teknaf coastal belt

COX'S BAZAR, Sept 24: Panic has gripped the Ukhiya-Teknaf coastal belt where hundreds of unidentified objects were seen floating in the Bay and occasionally exploding with flame and smoke, reports UNB.

Local fishermen said the round and about ten-inch long pipe-shaped objects have been floating in the waters over an area of about 10 to 12 km since Thursday. Some of these exploded while being examined by curious people injuring two of them. The victims, identified as Abdul Gafur, 17, and Altaf Hossain, 35, were admitted to local clinics.

Agri-rehabilitation body meets

SUNAMGANJ, Sept 24: A meeting of the district agriculture rehabilitation committee was held last week at the deputy commissioner's conference room here, reports BSS.

Deputy Commissioner Iqbal Hussain Khan presided over the meeting. Deputy Director, Agriculture Extension Department Abdul Muttalib Miah presented a report on the agricultural development in the district. The meeting was informed that 12,000 hectares have been brought under aus and aman cultivation in 10 thanas of the district. The target of production has been fixed at 15,000 metric tons.

Efforts on to make country self-reliant

KISHOREGANJ, Sept 24: LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman has said the main aim of the present government is to make every villages of the country economically self-reliant, reports UNB.

While addressing separate meetings as chief guest on Sunday at Kuliarchar and Bazipur he called upon all to elect the honest and dedicated people in the coming Union Parishad elections to accelerate the pace of development. He said for the development of rural people massive uplift programmes costing Tk 908 crore are being implemented in the current fiscal year. Besides, he said, the LGRD ministry has undertaken a programme to disburse Tk 173 crore small loan under the poverty alleviation programme.

College student electrocuted

GAIBANDHA, Sept 24: A college student of Sadar thana was electrocuted while giving electric connection to his house from the main line on Thursday, reports UNB.

The victim, identified as Zahidul Islam, 19, 2nd year student of Mahimaganj College and son of Tamjuddin of Gopalpur village, met the tragic end while trying to take the line with the help of a bamboo. The body was sent to Sadar hospital for autopsy. An unnatural death case was filed with the police.

APS to PM visits Madaripur College

MADARIPUR, Sept 24: Md Bahauddin Nasim, APS to the Prime Minister visited Madaripur Sufia Mohila College recently, reports BSS.

He talked with the students about their problems and conditions. A discussion was, later, held at the college auditorium. Presided over by the Principal of the college Md Jalaluddin, the meeting was also addressed by some professors. Besides, students and teaching staff local elite were also present in the meeting.

Facilities Deptt official's office attacked

PATUAKHALI, Sept 24: A group of miscreants attacked the office of the Executive Engineer of local Facilities Department on September 7 and snatched away about 50 tender forms from the office, reports BSS.

Local sources said, the miscreants also ransacked the office during the attack and had broken some doors and windows of the office. It is alleged that the miscreants attacked the office on the last date of selling tender forms regarding construction of 15 schools in Patuakhali. The general contractors were afraid of the situation created by these mastans. When contacted the executive engineer of the department, he admitted the occurrence and informed that the matter has been brought to the notice of the Deputy Commissioner and the Police Super. Local contractors urged the authority to ensure security the office premise against the mastans.

Last year's record
500 highway dacoities committed at night in S-W districts

JESSORE, Sept 24: Bus service during night time has become unsafe on all routes of South-Western zone of the country.

Steady rise in highway robberies has created this situation.

A total of 500 robberies were committed in night coaches and trucks on these routes in last year, according to a source.

But the actual figure of the incident was double. But nowhere including local thanas these incidents were properly recorded.

It has been reported that a trend has developed among passengers particularly business community to travel at night coach. The advantage to utilize day's work fully has been the reason of this trend.

Similarly truck drivers prefer to ply their vehicles at night in long routes. Many night coaches ply from Jessore, Khulna, Bagerhat, Satkhira, Benapole, Narail, Meherpur.

It has been learnt affected

Chuadanga and Kushtia districts to Dhaka, Chittagong, Barisal and Bogra. A good quantity of commercial goods are also being carried to other places of the country from Benapole and Mongla Ports by trucks.

According to a source of Bangladesh Transport Owners and Workers Association, there are many points on the highways passing through Jessore, Faridpur, Khulna and Kushtia districts, where robbery in night coaches and trucks is almost a regular feature.

It has been alleged, robbers travel in night coaches in disguise of passengers, rob away passengers at different points by stopping the coaches. Organised gangs also commit dacoity by some other practice.

Almost everyday, such incidents happen. But most of these occurrences are not recorded in thana.

passengers do not go to thana to avoid court attendance in connection with the case and loss of time and unnecessary expenses.

A spokesman of Bangladesh Transport Owners and Workers Association told this correspondent, if all the highway robberies were recorded with thana the total figure would have been double the existing figure.

FARIDPUR, Sept 22: People of all strata of society in the district town have expressed their anguish over police's non-acceptance of a rape and murder case.

One Shamima Begum went to file a case with Kotwali police on September 3 against five persons for gang raping and murdering her teenaged daughter Nipa. But police registered only a murder case in stead of case under child and woman oppression special act, 1995 under Section 6.

Huge quantity of liquor seized: 9 arrested

SIRAJGANJ, Sept 24: Detective Branch police seized huge quantity of foreign made liquor and arrested a man from a shop in the town on Tuesday, reports UNB.

Acting on a tip-off, police raided the shop Tani Confectionery at SS road and recovered the contraband. Police also arrested the shop-owner Gopintha Kumar Shah, 50, said to be a smuggler. The goods were deposited with Sadar thana.

A case was filed and Gobinda was sent to jail under Special Powers Act.

Another report from Sylhet says: Department of Narcotics Control (DNC) seized huge quantity of liquor and hemp and arrested eight people from different places of the district in six days.

Acting on a tip-off, DNC

raided two grocery shops at a bazar in Biswanath thana and recovered 68 bottles of Indian whisky, three bottles of ram, 15 litres country made liquor and 350 grams of hemp on Tuesday.

They also arrested shop owners Suvash Pal and Bivash Pal in connection with drug trafficking.

On the same day, in a sudden drive, four people were arrested with illegal drugs from Rab area near Osmani Airport in the town.

A man was nabbed along with 11 bottles liquor and 12 bottles Indian whisky from Zindabazar Government Girls' High School areas in the suburb on Saturday.

Another man was held along with 110 litres liquor and 1 kg hemp from Sunamganj district on September 18.

AL Govt is insincere, says Nizami

Internal conflicts during 3 months
13 activists of outlawed parties killed in Jhenidah

JHENIDAH, Sept 24: At least 13 activists of outlawed parties were killed in three months due to internal conflicts and by the rivals in the district.

Ruhuljel, 24, an activist of outlawed Biplabi Communist Party (BCP) of village Laxmipur under Kotchandpur thana was chopped to death at about 10 am on August 8 last.

Police said, a gang of armedmen numbering 13 to 14 killed him on the spot. Akbar Ali and Rajab Ali, two other activists of the same party received severe injuries during the clash.

Bablu, 20, and Momin, 25, both activists of BCP were chopped to death by a gang of armedmen in the night of July 27 last.

Police said, the abductors allegedly caught the victims at about 9:30 pm while they were returning after enjoying TV programme at village Khoshalpur in Kaliganj thana.

On July 28 last, Jamaluddin, 40, another activist of BCP at village Ramchandrapur under Harinakundu thana was slaughtered to death.

Police sources said, about 12 armedmen caught Jamal from his house at about 9 pm and chopped him to death on a nearby road. The killers might be the activists of Purbabanga Communist Party.

Shamsul Alam, 40, of village Hazintala under Mohepur thana of the district was shot dead on June 25. Police said, the killers caught Alam from his house and killed him on the spot. The reason behind the killing could not be known.

Anwar Hossain, 56, of village Estegapur under Jhenidah sadar thana was stabbed to death allegedly by his rivals on June 17 last.

Police said, Anwar was rushed to Jhenidah Sadar Hospital in a critical condition and

succumbed to his injuries there.

On May 10, Moksed Ali, 40, a BCP activist of village Balladanga under Jhenidah thana was chopped to death.

Police said, Moksed was sleeping in his house. At about 12 pm some armedmen called him from the house and killed him. Moksed was wanted by police in four cases, police said.

Amal Kumar, 22, of village Kalicharanpur under Jhenidah thana succumbed to his injuries at Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH). He received bullet injuries on May 6 last.

Police said, he might be an activist of an outlawed party.

The tragic end came when he was playing with a gun and a bullet suddenly came out of gun which hit him. Amal was rushed to Jhenidah Sadar Hospital.

On May 4, police said, Abdus Sattar, 47, an activist of Biplabi Communist Party of village Gopalpur in Jhenidah thana was shot dead by his rivals.

Police said, the killing might be a revenge of killing another outlawed party leader Rezaul Islam.

Laltu, 26, an activist of Biplabi Communist Party of village Chatura in Salkupa pourasabha alongwith two other leaders of the same party were killed near Boshigram WAPDA canal under Kumarkhali thana of Kushtia district on August 5 night. Police said, all the three were passing the canal road at about 12 pm.

Dulal, 30, an activist of the same party was shot dead by some unknown armedmen at Joradaha bazar under Harinakundu thana of the district about 7 pm on July 14 last.

Police said, the killers attacked him when he was gossiping at a local grocer shop.

About 50 to 60 buses ply in these two bus routes. Due to lack of passenger sheds passengers including women and children have to wait here and there near the bus stands. Most of the bus stands are located in the bazar areas. As a result the passengers especially women and children face troubles during hot days which sits twice in a week.
