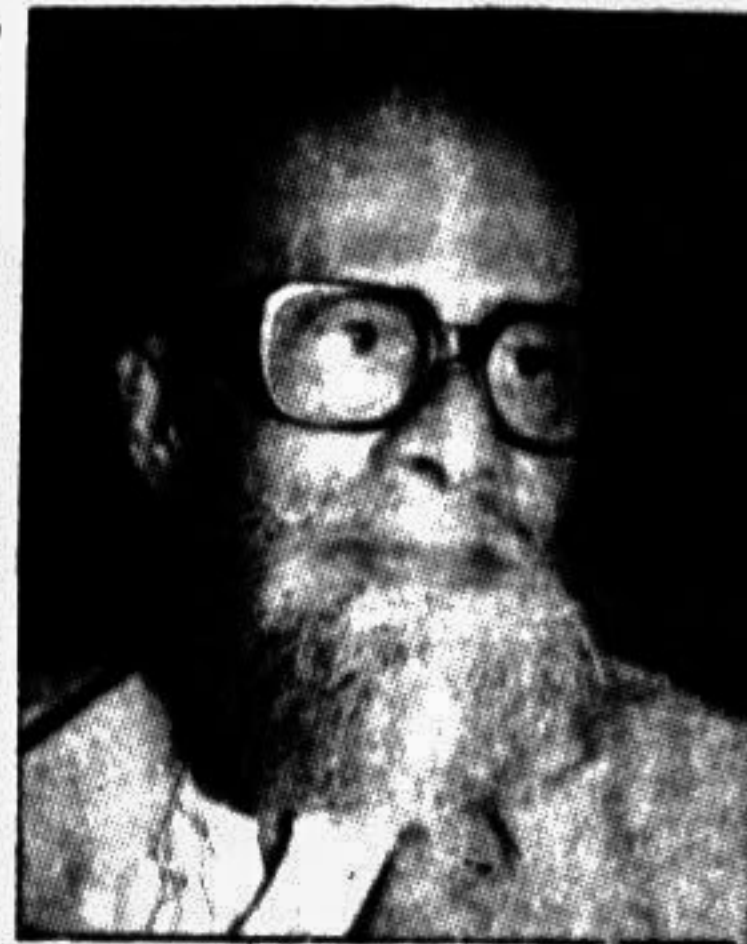

Heavy rainfall likely

Heavy rainfall is likely at places over the regions of Khulna, Barisal, Patuakhali, Noakhali, Comilla, Chittagong and Cox's Bazar during the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

Met Office also forecast heavy to very heavy fall at places over Khulna, Barisal, Chittagong, Dhaka and Sylhet divisions during the period.

Moderate to moderately heavy rain or thundershower accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind may also occur at most places over the country.

Day temperature may fall by 2 to 3 degree Celsius across the country.

In its outlook for subsequent two days weathermen predicted increase in rainfall activity and little change in the following five days.
