

Prof Mofizuddin's qulkhwani today



Qulkhwani of Dr Mofizuddin Ahmed, Professor Emeritus, Dhaka University will be held today after Asr prayers at his residence SWD-5. Road no 7, Gulshan in the city, says a press release.

Dr Mofizuddin Ahmed died Sept 26 at 11:00 am at the NICVD Hospital in the city. He leaves behind his wife, Sufia Ahmed, three daughters: Dr Nishat A Pasha, Professor, Dept of Chemistry, Dhaka University Yasmeen A Rahman, teacher at Sunbeams School, Dhaka and Dr Shaheen A Chowdhury at Florida, USA. three sons-in-laws and five grandchildren, besides numerous relatives, friends, colleagues and students. Prof Ahmed was buried at the Banani graveyard Friday evening.

Dr Ahmed was offered a Professor Emeritus position in 1983 by the University of Dhaka for his distinguished service and eminence in the field of Chemistry. Prof Ahmed was born on May 2, 1921. He had a brilliant academic career. He passed Bachelor of Science (Honors) in 1942 and Masters of Science in 1944 in Chemistry, securing the second position in first class from Dhaka University. In 1948 he obtained the PhD from the Pennsylvania University.

Since 1948 he has been teaching Organic Chemistry at the Dhaka University, first as a Senior Lecturer (1948-1950), then as a Reader (1950-1963). and finally, a Professor (1963-83). He distinguished himself by


