Viciosa's third in a row

NEW YORK, Sept 28: Isaac Viciosa of Spain won for the third straight year and Paula Radcliffe of Britain also successfully defended her title at the fifth Avenue Mile Road race on Saturday, reports Reuter. The races on one of New

York city's busiest thorough fares — a straight, generally flat avenue - attracted strong international fields. Viciosa won a competitive

race in which 17 of the 19 runners finished in under four minutes.

The Spaniard passed Britain's Anthony Whiteman with 100 metres to go and held off Whiteman in the final few strides. Viciosa finished in 3:53.66. Whiteman was next in 3:53.85, followed by Branko Zorko of Croatia in 3:54.21.

"When I saw the sign at 1,500 metres I knew it was my opportunity," said Viciosa, European silver medalist at 1500 in 1994. "I didn't mean to wait so long. There was so much speed behind me, I didn't know who might have a faster kick."

Whiteman said he was happier with his speed than his tactics. "I showed by hand too early," he said. "It was a great challenge for me because of the quality of the field, but on a course like this you see the line so soon and it takes forever to get there. Maybe I might have waited.

Radcliffe, a silver medalist at the 1997 World Cross Country Championships, assumed command in the first 200 metres and never looked back, snapping the finish tape in 4 minutes, 22.96 seconds, her career-best on any surface.

Ireland's Sinead Delahunty broke free from a tightly bunched trail pack in the final quarter-mile to take second in 4:24.87, followed by Kathy Francy of the United States in 4:26.30.

"I was a little concerned about the race because I've done so little preparation on the roads," said Radcliffe, who trained in the Pyranees this summer. "I wanted to stay aggressive.

"The course has one crest at the half mile, and a lot of people get over it and ease up on the downhill. I made sure to go hard and stay strong through the
