The Detective Branch (DB) of police recovered a number of bottles of foreign liquor and cans of beer and arrested one person in this connection from Sutrapur area in the city Saturday night.

Police said the arrested was identified as Din Islam alias Hanif, 20.

During a raid a DB team seized 80 bottles of foreign alcohol and 146 cans of beer from inside a godown at Kaptanbazar at about 9 pm.

One held with arms in Moghbazar area

The Detective Branch (DB) of police arrested a gangster with a firearm from Moghbazar area in the city yesterday afternoon.

Acting on a tip-off, a DB team arrested Nazir Ullah, 19, from in front of Century Arcade market at about 3:30 pm. Police seized a pistol with seven rounds of live bullets from the arrested person.

Nazir had been involved in collecting tolls by brandishing firearms in Ramna, Motijheel and Shabujbagh area since a long time, police said.

Tk 4.75 lakh sanctioned as relief for cyclone victims

The government has taken up massive rehabilitation work to assist the people affected by the recent cyclone and tidal waves in the southern coastal districts, reports BSS.

The Ministry of Relief and Disaster Management has sanctioned Taka 4.75,000 in cash for relief of the cyclone victims. Besides, it has sanctioned 200 metric tons of rice, 2,500 lungies and 500 tins of biscuits for

immediate distribution among the affected people.

These sanctions are in addition to 20 metric tons of rice and Taka 50,000 allotted earlier through each deputy commissioner for immediate relief.

The Ministry of Relief and Disaster Management is reviewing the overall situation and assessing the requirement to sanction more relief for the cyclone victims, a ministry source said.

Meanwhile, Commerce and Industries Minister Tofael Ahmed yesterday visited the storm battered areas of Bhola. He talked to the affected people and distributed cash relief.

While visiting Bhabanipur, Shahrerhat, Hajipur and Kalamarihat under Daulatkhan thana which were worst hit by the recent cyclone, Tofael directed the concerned authorities to issue vulnerable group feeding (VGF) cards to the distressed women.

Listing various measures for rehabilitation of the cyclone-hit people, Tofael said arrangements were being made to provide lease of khas land including ponds, ditches and fallow land for generating self-employment. He also visited various parts of Lalmonirhat and Borhanuddin.

Shipping Minister A S M Abdur Rob also visited affected areas of Rangati thana, where he told the people that efforts were underway to identify the people who suffered loss due to the cyclonic storm. He also assured them of all help from the government.

Control room opens in ADAB office

A control room has been opened in the office of ADAB for effective coordination of the relief and rehabilitation activities conducted by the NGOs in the cyclone affected areas, reports BSS.

All concerned have been requested to send all information to this room on emergency basis regarding emergency relief and rehabilitation specially of those areas where no relief reached as yet.

The decision was taken in a meeting of the NGOs held in ADAB office yesterday afternoon with its director Shamsul Huda in the chair. Director general of NGO Bureau Giasuddin Pathan and director of disaster management bureau Abdul Aweel Chowdhury were present in the meeting.

The meeting decided to conduct an aerial survey of the cyclone hit areas on emergency basis through ADAB with the assistance of international organisation MSF Sweden. It also called upon the government to undertake speedy initiative regarding the missing fishermen.

Besides, the meeting called upon the concerned NGOs to undertake activities on emergency basis for supply of pure drinking water, sanitation and primary health care.

The meeting observed one minute silence in respect of the people killed in the cyclone.
