Referring to a study conducted by him and his associates on around 2,500 people of both urban and rural areas, he said the prevalence of diabetes among rich people both in urban and rural areas was found higher than that of the poor. "Diabetes is a disease of

civilisation." Sayeed said. adding in Bangladesh, unplanned development, change of lifestyle such as consumption of processed food then natural food, lack of physical acthe underweight babies (body weight less than 2.5 kg) suffer from diabetes at their age of

Some 8 per cent of 30 to 64year-old people suffer from diabetes in urban while 4 per cent in rural areas.

On the other hand, about 5 per cent have IGT (Impaired Glucose Tolerance) in urban while about 12 per cent in rural

IGT is a preliminary stage of diabetes, and the study of the consequences of IGT shows that some 33 per cent fall into dia betes, 33 per cent back to nor mal condition and rest sustained in IGT

The researcher said short female has more possibilities of diabetes than the tall.

When contacted. Principal Research Officer Liaquat Ali of the diabetic hospital said 3,000 diabetics are getting medicare service at BIRDEM everyday. Such number of patients at a time is the highest in any health-care institution across the world," he observed.

about 2 lakh patients currently had been registered of which 1.5 lakh in BIRDEM and rest in other centres in the country. He said the expenditure of
