## Session jam in JU Pharmacy Deptt

Students of Pharmacy Department in Jahangirnagar University (JU) are left to their fate because of unexpected delay in holding their examinations and in publishing results.

Students of the department complained that examinations of different academic years are often delayed and they usually get their results at least one year after the examinations are held.

The students of the session 1989-90 who completed their M. Pharm examinations in November last year are still awaiting their results while their batchmates in other departments passed out at least two years ago.

Schedule for Masters examinations for the students of 1990-91 session is yet to be announced, but the corresponding students in other departments already completed their Masters last year.

Also, students of the session 1991-92 are waiting for their honours final examinations while their batchmates in other departments are scheduled to complete their Masters examinations within this year.

A member of students of the department told this correspondent, on condition of anonymity, that some teachers' reluctance in taking classes and unexpected delay in looking over answer scripts created the back log of academic years.

Talking to The Daily Star, department Chairman A Y S Firozuddin Ahmed Chowdhury said, "We are concerned over the situation and trying our best to remove the academic backlog by December this year."

## Alleged child trafficker held

Police arrested a woman allegedly involved in child trafficking from Ganderia under Shurapur thana in the city Tuesday.

Kolomi Begum, 40, was caught by a section of local people when she allegedly tried to lure Sahidur Rahman, 10, to go with her. As the boy denied to do so, she forcibly tried to pick him up at Kalicharan Saha Road at about 11:30 am.

Local people caught Kolomi as Sahidur started crying for help. The agitated people rescued the boy and handed the woman over to police. Later, police arrested the woman.

Shurapur police said the woman is likely to be produced before the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's court today. A case was filed under the Women and Children Repression Act, 1995 with Shurapur thana in this regard.

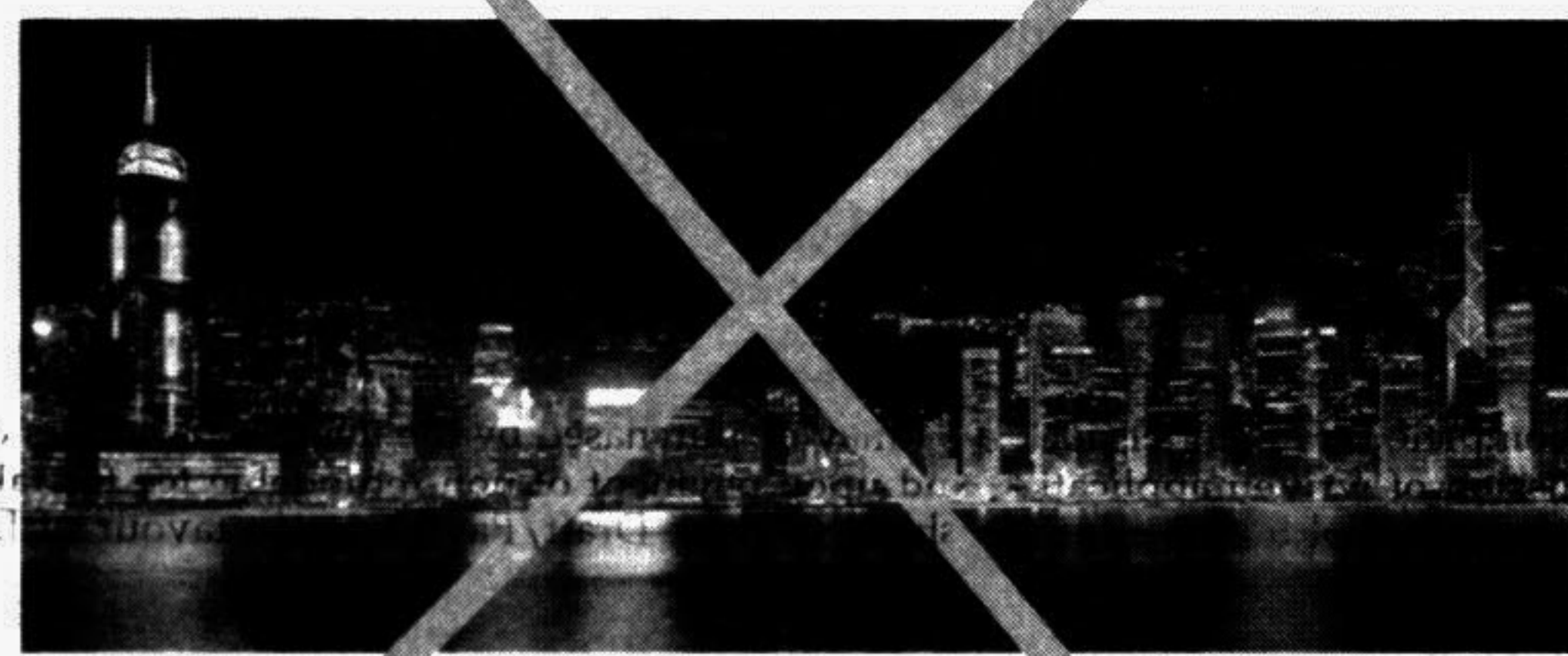
