## DU orientation programme held

The education system of the country cannot keep pace with that of the other parts of the world resulting in serious setback in the quality of education, said the Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University yesterday.

Prof Chowdhury was speaking as chief guest at an orientation programme of the first year honours students of the Department of Public Administration, International Relations, Anthropology, Social Welfare, Law and IBA of the university, held at the TSC auditorium.

The VC said that the main objective of education was to produce ideal people. He urged the students to devote themselves to study, giving up terrorism.

Student Adviser and Counselling Centre of the university organised the orientation programme.

Presided over by Prof Hamida Akter Begum, the programme was also addressed by the Dean of the Faculty of Social Science Prof Asaduzzaman, Dean of the Faculty of Law Prof M Irsihadul Bari, chairman of the departments and the student advisers.

## Samajbadi Dal team meets PM

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday said that her government is determined to alleviate poverty through creating income generation and self-employment opportunities in the country, reports BSS.

Talking to a delegation of Sramik Krishak Samajbadi Dal at her office, Sheikh Hasina said that the country's fallow lands and government owned water-bodies would be allotted to trained unemployed youths for multipurpose projects.

The Prime Minister said that necessary financial assistance would be provided to the unemployed youths for poultry farms and fish culture and other income generating activities.

The Prime Minister told the delegation that the leader of the opposition never attends the meetings of the advisors committee of the parliament which is very vital for smooth running of the activities of the Sangsad.

The delegation leader said that a white paper should be published on the corruption, nepotism and all other misdeeds of the previous government.

Led by party general secretary Nirmal Sen, the delegation included party leaders Siddique Rahaman, Belayet Hossain Sikder, Mosaddek Hossain, Kazi Hares Ahmed, Anupama Bhaumik and Mamunur Rashid.

## Tk 700 crore Non-formal Edn Programme undertaken

CHITTAGONG, Oct 2: The government has undertaken a Tk 700-crore Non-formal Education Programme from its own resources, reports UNB.

Primary and Mass Education Secretary Dr Sadat Hossain disclosed this while addressing an orientation and review meeting on non-formal adult education of Chittagong division at the local circuit house on Wednesday.

Organised by Non-formal Education Directorate, the meeting was presided over by the Divisional Commissioner M Sakhawat Hossain.
