Biman U-14 championship 8 more in zonal semis

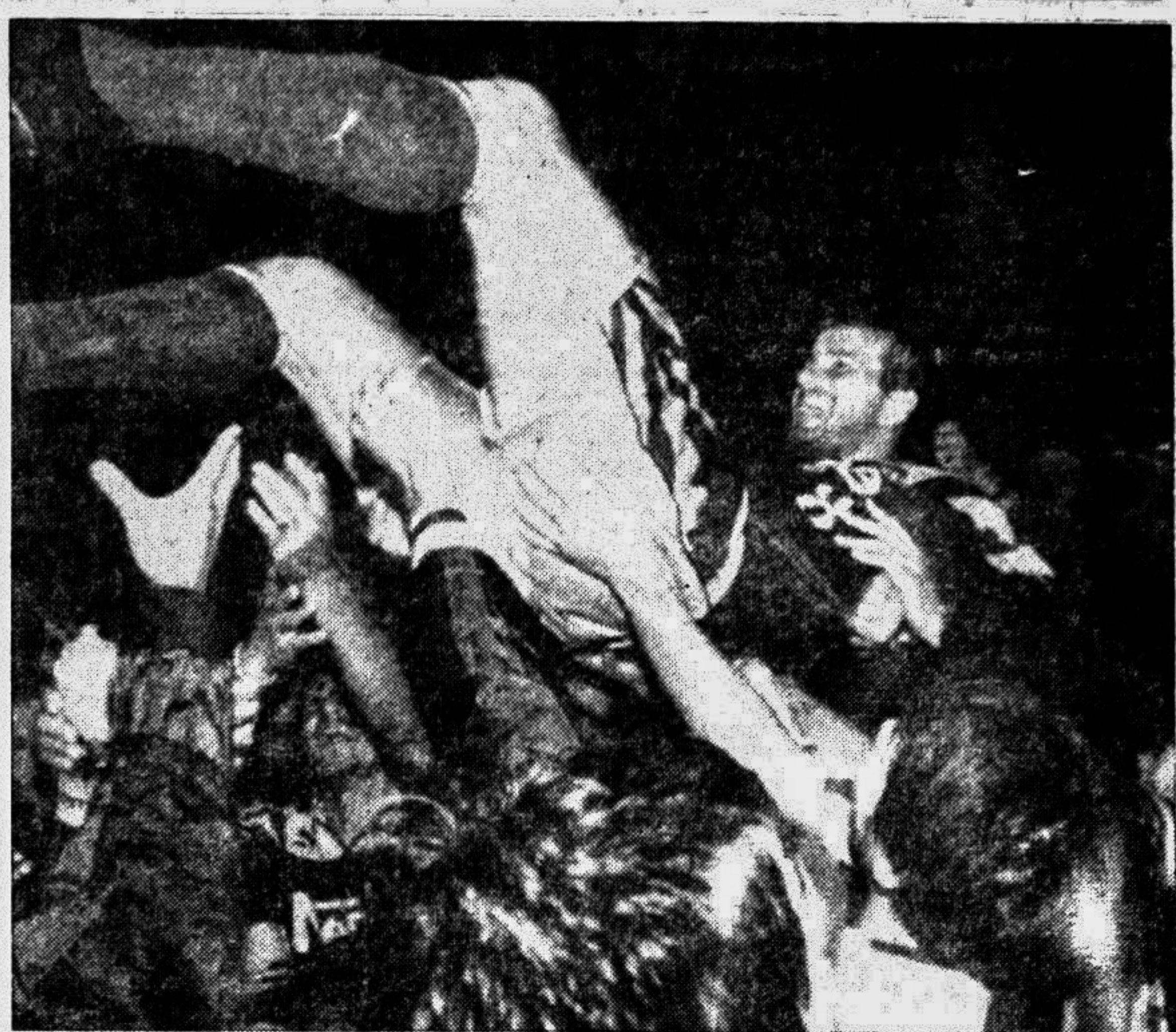
