Dhaka expresses concern over ME situation

Bangladesh has expressed its concern over the present situation in the Middle East saying the Israeli government should adhere to the principles of peace process and implement the agreements signed in this regard, reports BSS.

Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad in a statement made at the annual coordination meeting of the OIC foreign ministers at the UN headquarters on Thursday voiced Bangladesh's continued support to the on-going Middle East peace process, a message received in Dhaka yesterday said.

Azad said peace process would enable the Palestinian people to exercise their inalienable rights provided for in relevant United Nations and OIC resolutions. He said the international community should put pressure on Israel compelling the Jewish state to comply with their commitment to the peace process.

The Foreign Minister expressed Bangladesh's concern at the present situation in the Middle East caused due to arrogant and provocative measures of the Netanyahu government, including the blockade imposed on the Palestinian people and its continued inhuman practices.

1. The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a loan from Asian Development Bank [Loan # 1123-BAN (SF)] for Higher Secondary Education Project under Ministry of Education. A portion of the loan proceeds has been earmarked for procurement of learning material (Laser Printer, UPS & Voltage Stabilizer)

2. The Programs Director, Higher Secondary Education Project, Directorate of Secondary and Higher Education, House # 13, Road # 4, Dhamondi R/A, Dhaka-1205 now invites sealed tenders in prescribed form from the Manufacturers/Agents/Distributors/Bona fide Dealers/Suppliers of learning material (Laser Printer, UPS & Voltage Stabilizer) of ADB

reports UNB. According to university sources, about 1000 probe committees were formed in last 44 years since the establishment of the university in 1953. The committees were formed to investigate 26 murder cases on the campus, money misappropriation in purchasing books for the library, question paper leakage, irregularities in publishing results, clashes between student organisations, ransacking and setting fire to halls and ransacking the VC's house.

Some punitive actions had been taken in some cases, but the probe committee reports never saw the light of day.

In 1990, punitive measures were taken against the then acting Librarian and some other employees of the University Central Library on the basis of an enquiry report prepared by the committee in an allegation of money misappropriation.

Recently, the Controller of Examination of the university has been made OSD (officer on special duty) and two others suspended on charge of irregularities.

Several enquiry committees have been formed between 1973 and 1996 to probe 26 incidents of killings and other terrorist acts on the campus.

A fierce clash between two rival groups of students that occurred on February 6, 1993 left five students dead and over 100 injured. Property worth about Tk four lakh in four dormitories were also damaged during the clash.

After the incident, the government had formed a probe committee headed by a judge. But the university authorities are yet to publish the report although the judge submitted his report to the authorities.

According to an official of the university, the authorities had received all the probe committee reports, but did not publish those for unknown reasons.

Another official unwilling to be named said mainly the university teachers are picked as the members of the probe body formed in connection with corruption and irregularities. It may be a reason behind concealing the reports, he added.

Students, teachers and officials said a congenial academic atmosphere would be created in the Rajshahi University if the reports are published to take punitive actions against the offenders.

5. The bidders will have to submit their technical proposal and financial proposal in separate envelop properly sealed. The technical offers will be opened in the bid opening date in presence of the bidders, if any. After technical evaluation of the bids only technically fitted bidders' financial offer will be opened in the meeting of the Tender Committee in presence of technically qualified bidders (if present). Technically unsuccessful bidders' financial offers will be returned unopened.

6. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond of Tk 2% of the total quoted price in the form of Bank Draft/Pay Order from any scheduled bank of Dhaka City in favour of the Programs Director, Higher Secondary Education Project, House # 13, Road # 4, Dhamondi R/A, Dhaka, Bangladesh.

7.
