In a press release, Sigma Huda noted that on Sunday last, a seven-year-old girl was raped by a youth in Jabra area of Ghor Thana in Manikganj. Some school students later recovered her in a serious condition.

Sigma added that in Dhaka, rapists severed the breasts of college student when her father and brother tried to rescue her from them.

The BSEHR urged the Home Ministry to pursue both the cases and take proper action.

Law to try fundamentalists in special tribunal urged

Leaders of different women organisations yesterday demanded trial of the fundamentalist communal elements who are out to destroy the spirit of the War of Liberation in special tribunal by enacting new law, reports BSS.

The anti-liberation fundamentalist forces are hatching a conspiracy against the independence of Bangladesh and trying to create unrest in the country at a time when the trial of the killers of Bangabandhu has been started, they told a rally, organised by the pro-liberation women activists at the Outer Stadium in the city.

Addressing the rally, Environment and Forest Minister Sayeda Sajeda Chowdhury, who is also a convenor of Mohila Mukti Juddha Sangsad, alleged that all fundamentalist forces in connivance with the BNP were involved in turning the country into another "Afghanistan" through a so-called Taliban style revolution.

The minister urged all pro-liberation forces including women, to be united against the anti-liberation fundamentalists for establishing a Rajakar-free Bangladesh.

The rally was followed by a procession which paraded different city street, terminating at the home minister.
