Index slides on lower volume

At the close of trading on October 8, 1997

The Dhaka Stock Exchange All Share Price Index slid by 3.94 points on lower volume on Wednesday.

The composite index declined to 980.86 points from 984.80 points. The market capitalisation of the bourse lost Tk 33.68 crore to Tk 8375.65 crore from Tk 8409.33 crore.

Trading in terms of volume decreased by 12 per cent and four per cent in terms of value. As many as 5.81 lakh shares and debentures worth Tk 9.83 crore changed hands as against previous day's 6.59 lakh shares and debentures valued at Tk 10.25 crore.

Losers outnumbered the gainers by 94 to 42 while price of one issue remained unchanged among 137 traded issues. Monno Jute was the top

gainer with a rise of Tk 136.67 per share while United Leasing Company led the losers with a fall of Tk 66.79 per share.

Islamic Bank, Uttara Finance, Bangladesh Leaf Tobacco, BD Zipper Industries (Deb) and BD Luggage Industries (Deb) were also significant gainers.

IDLC, Aziz Pipes Singer Bangladesh, Wata Chemical and Third ICB MF were also among losers of the day.
