Scaffolding of theatre bldg collapses: 6 hurt

At least six construction workers were injured when a portion of a scaffolding of the under-construction National Theatre building collapsed at the Shilpkala Academy premises at Shegunbagicha in the city Thursday.

Of the injured, five identified as Hakim, 35, Bulu 25, Anis 22, Amzad, 25, and Rahim, 20, were taken to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital. All of them were released after treatment, hospital sources said.

3 injured in cracker blast

At least two women and a child were injured in a cracker explosion and one person was beaten up by a mob in this connection in Hazaribagh area under Dhamondi thana in the city Thursday evening.

Dhaka Medical College Hospital sources said Rimu, 8, Monwara, 20 and Parul, 25, were wounded when a cracker exploded beside the rickshaw on which they were traveling on Moneswar Road near BDR gate No. five at about 6:30 pm.

They were admitted to the hospital for treatment.

Meanwhile, soon after the incident a section of local people beat up a man identified as Shahjahan, suspecting him to be a member of a gang of snatchers which exploded the cracker.

Police rescued Shahjahan from the mob in an injured condition, arrested him and took him to DMCH.
