**Cultural show to raise funds for cancer research**

Top artistes of Bangladesh will bring to life an unusual story of life and death this week in the city to raise funds for cancer research, paying tribute to legendary Terry Fox, reports UNB.

The 'Terry Fox Story' will form the centrepiece of a cultural show to be presented by the Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy on Wednesday at the National Museum auditorium. The show will also include the wellknown dance drama, *Nakshi Kathar Math*, performed by top artistes Shamim Ara Nipa and Sohail Rahman together with the Academy's renowned performers.

The event is part of a month-long drive to raise funds for cancer research in the country, which will culminate in the Terry Fox Run on Oct 31.

The charity show is being organised by the Ministry of Cultural Affairs, the Canadian High Commission, the Rotary Clubs of Bangladesh, the Bangladesh Cancer Research Society and the Terry Fox Organising Committee.

The Director General of Shilpakala Academy, Azad Rahman, himself a renowned artist, has composed a dance drama based on the life of Terry Fox, especially for the show.

**Journalists rally today**

A rally of the journalists will be held today at 11 am at the premises of the National Press Club under the joint auspices of BFUJ and DUJ, reports BSS.

The journalists of the country will also observe three-hour token strike today from 10 am to 1 pm.

Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) called the countrywide three-hour token strike in all newspapers and news agencies for realisation of various demands including the implementation of the fifth Wage Board Award for the journalists and workers in the newspaper industry, payment of arrear salary and halting of all termination from the job.

**SAARC workshop on paediatrics in city Oct 14**

A SAARC pre-congress workshop on 'Paediatrics in Undergraduate Medical Curriculum' will be held in the city on October 14. The workshop, to be held at Hotel Sheraton, is expected to be attended by around 20 child specialists from seven South Asian countries, a press release of the Bangladesh Paediatric Association (BPA) said.

Meanwhile, a three-day 12th biennial conference of the BPA will begin at Hotel Sonargaon on Oct 15, the press release added. Registration of the participants will begin at 8:00 am.

**Police prevents SSF procession**

Police Friday prevented the Samajtantrik Sramik Front (SSF), a national level labour organisation, from bringing out a procession in the Topkhana road in the city, although there was no government announcement of banning processions on the streets, an SSF press release said yesterday.

"The government has officially imposed ban on holding rallies on the streets, but the police yesterday obstructed us to bring out a procession in the Topkhana road," the press release added.

The SSF brought out the procession in protest against physical assault against one of its leaders Nafmuddin, allegedly by some hired hoodlums of ship breakers in Chittagong the day before.


