'No substitute for satellite data in forecasting cyclone'

Dr A M Choudhury, chief of the research wing of SPARRSO said that there is no substitute for satellite data in forecasting the magnitude of cyclone, reports BSS.

He said as there is no meteorological observatory in the Bay of Bengal, only satellite data can provide reliable obser vation on cyclone in this area. He noted that the radar observation is limited only upto two hundred miles, so it does not see a cyclone until it is within that range, and frequently the core and tail of a cyclone extends more than the range of the radar

. The scientist was addressing a seminar on "monitoring of Sept 26, 1997 cyclone" at the SPARRSO auditorium at Agargaon in the city on Sunday.

He said SPARRSO ground station for the reception of weather satellite pictures has been upgraded many times and the last upgradation was made in 1990.
