Drug abuse increasing rapidly in Bangladesh

Speakers at a workshop in the city yesterday said Bangladesh has become a drug "consumer country", reports

They said initially drug abuse was thought to be prevalent among city dwellers, but the problem has recently spread even to the far remote areas of the country.

Their observations came from a daylong workshop on the "Role of Media in Drug Abuse Control in Bangladesh" held at the WVA auditorium at Dhanmondi.

Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof AK Azad Chowdhury opened the inaugural session of the workshop. jointly organised by Department of Narcotics Control (DNC) and United Nations International Drug Control Programme (UNDCP)

It was addressed, among others, by DNC DG Nazmul Ahsan Chowdhury, Bangladesh Times Editor AM Molazzel, BFUJ President Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury, Khondker A Hafiz of UNDCP, Dr Sakhat Ali Khan, Dr Shaikh Abdus Salam and Mohammed Jahangir. They said most vulnerable

group of drug users in Bangladesh is aged between 18 to 30 years and drug abuse is rapidly increasing as the country is used as a corridor for drug trafficking, mostly to North American and European coun-

Dr Syed Kamaluddin and Dr M Golam Rahman presented keynote papers at the work-

In his paper, Kamaluddin said about 80 per cent of the drug addicts are aged between 20 to 34 and of them, 36 per cent are unemployed, 25 per cent self-employed and 12 per cent students.

Prof Azad Chowdhury at tributed the growing drug menace to frustration, affluence, lack of parental care, easy availability of drugs, curiosity and peer pressure.

In the concluding session. the participating journalists put forward some suggestions to deal with the growing problem which included proper implementation of existing laws and building up of awareness through the media.

Bangladeshi killed in Belgium: Govt urged to lodge formal protest

By Staff Correspondent Jatiya Samannaya Committee yesterday urged the government to lodge a formal protest with the government of Pakistan for the killing of a Bangladeshi national allegedly by some Pakistani citizens in Belgium.

The call came from a press conference of the Samannaya Committee held at the BMA building in the city.

A Bangladeshi citizen, M Hossain Gagan, was stabbed to death by three Pakistani citi-

zens on Oct 5 in Belgium. The leaders of the committee also urged the government to request the Belgian government to take necessary action for trying the killers.

Gagan, who was a member of the Samannaya Committee. Mohammadpur unit, went to

Belgium to visit his brother. The leaders also urged the government to take necessary steps for ensuring the safety of Bangladeshis abroad.

The Samannaya Committee will submit a memorandum to the ministry of Foreign Affairs at 11 am today and also lodge a protest with the Pakistan mission in Dhaka on Oct 19.




