The programmes include holding of 'Nazrul Fair' in all district and divisional towns, cultural functions and competitions, special programmes on television and release of commemorative stamps.

Prabarana Purnima programme in Chittagong

CHITTAGONG, Oct 14: The Buddhists will celebrate one of their major festivals Prabarana Purnima here and elsewhere in the district tomorrow with traditional enthusiasm and due religious fervour, reports BSS.

The Buddhists in Bangladesh celebrate the Purnima in commemoration of ending of three months long seclusion of the Buddhist monks inside the monasteries and beginning of one month long yellow robe giving ceremony from the day after tomorrow in different parts of the country.

The purnima will be celebrated in all Buddhist monasteries through day-long programmes which included hoisting of the national and religious flags atop all Buddhist monasteries, chanting of the sacred verses from The Tripitaka.

Feeding to the Buddhist monks, shilgrahan, mass prayer, blood donation and discussion meetings are also highlighted in the programmes.

The main attraction of the day's programmes is releasing lighted balloons in the sky in the evening simultaneously from all monasteries.

In the city, main congregations will be held at Nandankanan Buddhist Temple, Navapandit Vihar at Katalganj, International Purnachar Bouddha Vihar at Dev Pahar, Sarbojonin Bouddha Vihar at Momin Road, Agrabad Biswa Moitri Bouddha Vihar.

Special prayers will also be held at Buddhist monasteries seeking continuous peace and progress of the nation as well as global peace.

The purnima will also be celebrated in a befitting manner in the Buddhist populated regions of Chittagong Hill Tracts, Cox's Bazar, Noakhali, Comilla and Patuakhali.
