

LYON, France, Oct 17: British number two and eighth seed Tim Henman crashed out of the 750,000-dollar

ATP Tour event here Thursday. osing 6-3, 6-4 in barely an hour Germany's Marc-Kevin Goellner, reports AFP. .

The 23-year-old Henman, who has secured two tour wins on the circuit this season while also reaching two finals, appeared curiously out of sorts against Goellner, six foot five and playing in his trademark back to front baseball cap.

A bemused Henman found himself up against a man at the top of his game with the big German serving superbly throughout, wrapping up the opening set with ease with a break in the sixth game before establishing a 4-2 lead in the second against his opponent by breaking for 2-1.


It was only then that Henman, ranked 18 in the world and averaging more than eight aces per match on the circuit this season, finally managed his first of the evening to get back to 4-3.

But the German, ranked just 61 on the ATP computer, closed out the Wimbledon quarter-finalist again to serve out for the match at 5-4.

After going 30-0 behind, Henman pulled off a brilliant crosscourt return to claw his way back to 30-15 but then netted after scampering across for a Goellner forehand hit short.

But having faulted again, he then hammered a superb stopping double-fisted return down the line to kill of any hope Henman had of making a last ditch recovery against the man
