

## News snaps

### 2 killed in Sirajganj road accident

SIRAJGANJ, Oct 22: Two people were killed in separate road mishaps on Uttarabanga highway in the district on Wednesday. Police and hospital sources said, reports UNB.

Monir, 35, son of Surat Ali, was run over by a Boga bound truck at Chala in Ullapara thana at about 4 pm and succumbed on way to Purnimaganj Health Complex, Saleha, 10, was crushed under the wheels of a Nagarbari bound truck at Sarishakeli in Shajadpur thana at 5 pm. Separate cases have been filed with the police.

### Miscecreants attack UP member

FENI, Oct 22: A member of GM Hat Union Parishad in Fulgazi thana was critically injured in an attack by miscreants on Thursday, reports UNB.

Witnesses said a group of 10-15 armed miscreants, reportedly led by 'Nizam dacoit', attacked Shahidullah at the UP office while distributing wheat among distressed mothers at about 12 noon. The attackers dragged him to a nearby saw-mill and beat him up severely. Local people rescued Shahidullah and sent him to Feni Sadar Hospital. His condition was stated to be critical.

### Bridge construction work progressing

RANGPUR, Oct 22: Construction works of two bridges over Shakoya river at Dahagram-Angarpota enclave are expected to be completed by December this year, reports UNB.

The Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) is implementing the project at a cost of Tk 22 lakh, according to officials. Upon completion of the 40-metre long bridges at Baghanbari and Dahagram Primary School, the road communication between Patgram thana headquarters and the enclave will be much easier. Thirty per cent works on the bridges have already been completed, the officials said.

### Huge quantity of smuggled goods seized

SYLHET, Oct 22: Police seized huge quantity of smuggled Indian goods from five boats at Dola Khal in Baniabazar thana on Thursday, reports UNB.

Acting on a tip-off, police raided the boats at about 10 am and recovered Indian sugar, salt, lentil, timber worth about Tk 2 lakh. Another report from Jhenidah says: Customs officials of Jessore zone recovered Indian goods worth about Tk 5.29 lakh from villages Monoharpur and Naldanga in Kaliganj thana on October 6. The seized goods, including synthetic cloths and sarees, were deposited with the divisional Customs office.

### Token hunger strike by Ctg newsmen

CHITTAGONG, Oct 22: Journalists here on Sunday observed an eight-hour token hunger strike at press club premises to press home their various demands including implementation of the Fifth Wage Board Award and payment of outstanding of the Dearness Allowances, reports BSS.

Held under the auspices of Chittagong Union of Journalists (CUJ) the country-wide token strike was observed in response to the call of Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists demanding establishment of special court and appointment of inspector to ensure proper implementation of the Wage Board, according to Newspapers Employees (condition of service) Acts, 1974. Chittagong City Mayor Alhaj ABM Mahiuddin Chowdhury broke the hunger strike by offering soft-drinks to the participants of the strike.

### Mugger caught by villagers

TANGAIL, Oct 22: Villagers caught an armed mugger trying to snatch a motorcycle from a man at Nikoly village in Bhuapur thana on Sunday, reports UNB.

Police said the villagers caught Mukhlesur Rahman red-handed when he along with his associates tried to snatch the motorcycle of one Mofakharul Islam in the morning. Later, police arrested Mukhlesur and recovered a revolver from his possession.

## AL leader arrested, released

RAJSHAHI, Oct 22: Alhaj Rafiquddin, central committee member of ruling Awami League, who was arrested on Saturday evening following a clash between the supporters of two factions of the local unit of Awami League was released on Sunday evening.

When contacted, a reliable source of Awami League said, Alhaj Rafiquddin was arrested when he went to Boalia thana for filing a case in connection with Saturday evening's clash. He was taken to the office of Rajshahi Metropolitan Police (RMP) Commissioner on Sunday afternoon by police van from where he was released through a negotiation meeting among the leaders of the two factions in presence of RMP commissioner.

It was mentioned here, a violent clash took place between the supporters of the two factions that left at least 10 persons injured.

## Jamulpur flood victims in misery

JAMALPUR, Oct 22: The flood affected people in the district have been leading a miserable life for want of food and pure drinking water.

Over three lakh agricultural labourers have become unemployed. The peasants have no jobs as their crop fields are still under water causing heavy damage to standing crop. They are passing their days half-fed or unfed.

About 95 per cent people of Jamalpur district are farmers who have been facing natural calamities every year.

Most of the people have no purchasing capacity. Price hike of essentials has further deteriorated the situation.

Most of the rural huts and bazzars have gone under water. As a result the traders cannot carry out their business. The road communication has been disrupted due to inundation of roads.

## 11 Patuakhali BCL leaders

BARISAL, Oct 22: A case has been lodged against 11 Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) leaders of Patuakhali on the charge of taking illegal possession of Patuakhali district BNP office.

District BNP General Secretary Alhaj Sahajahan Khan filed the case with Patuakhali sadar thana against these BCL leaders including Kaosar Ahmed Mridha, BCL Patuakhali district committee secretary. District BCL activists took possession of that office almost without resistance on Saturday last amid factional problems between two groups of local BNP leaders.

Patuakhali district Awami League in a statement claimed that taking possession of the said office by BCL is legal so that the case filed by BNP is flimsy, false and baseless.

## Rejoinder

Saptagram Nari Swanirvar Parishad on October 12 has sent a rejoinder for printing a report on October 11 that "Eighty officials and employees of Saptagram Nari Swanirvar Parishad a non-governmental organisation (NGO) resigned en masse in protest against alleged corruption and irregularities by some executives of the Parishad."

Following is Saptagram's version. "On the 1st of August 1997 total number of our staff in Faridpur was not more than 85. On the 10th of August we terminated the services of about thirty-five intractable staff. None has resigned from our organisation in Faridpur en masse or otherwise on moral ground as your correspondent has stated. Most of the dismissed staff have already taken their arrear pay, provident fund and gratuity and have left the workplace. Handful of others have asked for few days grace to vacate the residential centre they are living in."
