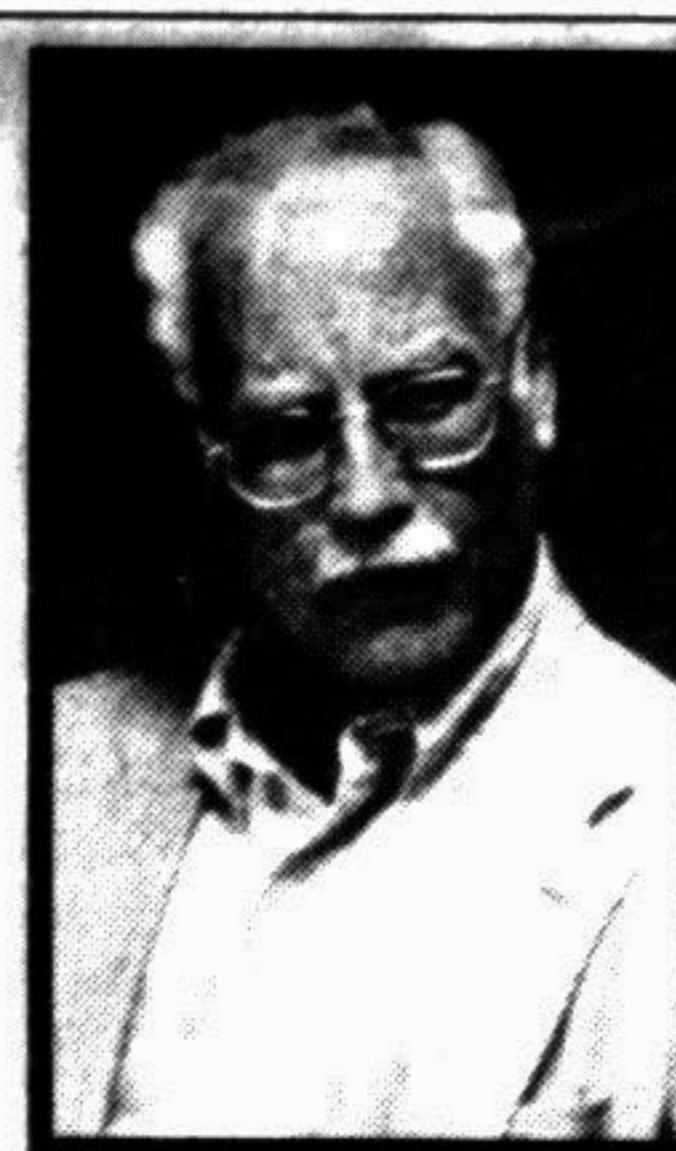

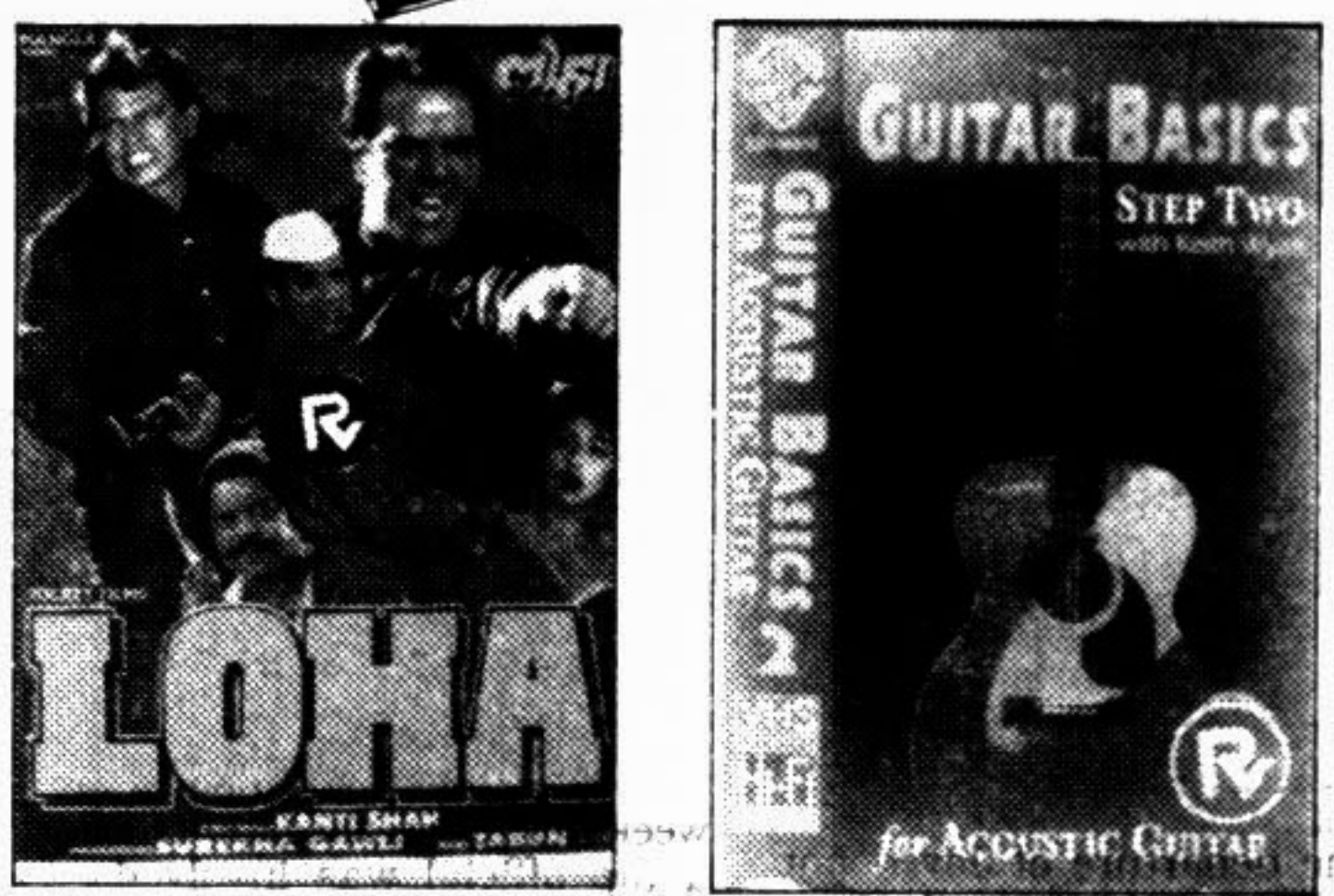
Mr. Holland's Opus

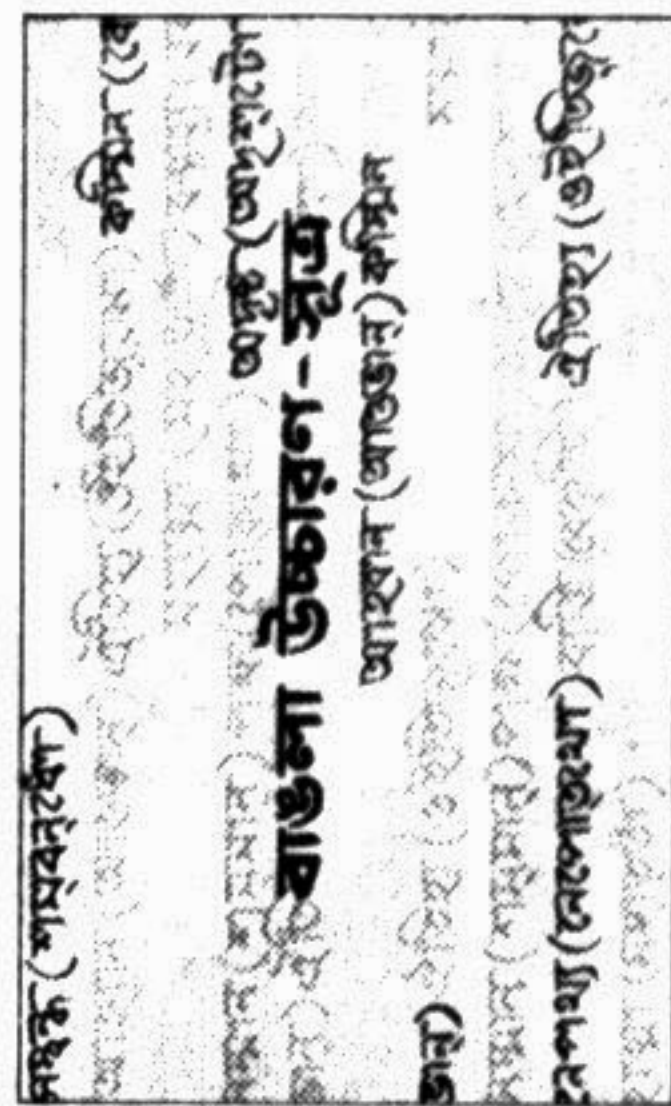

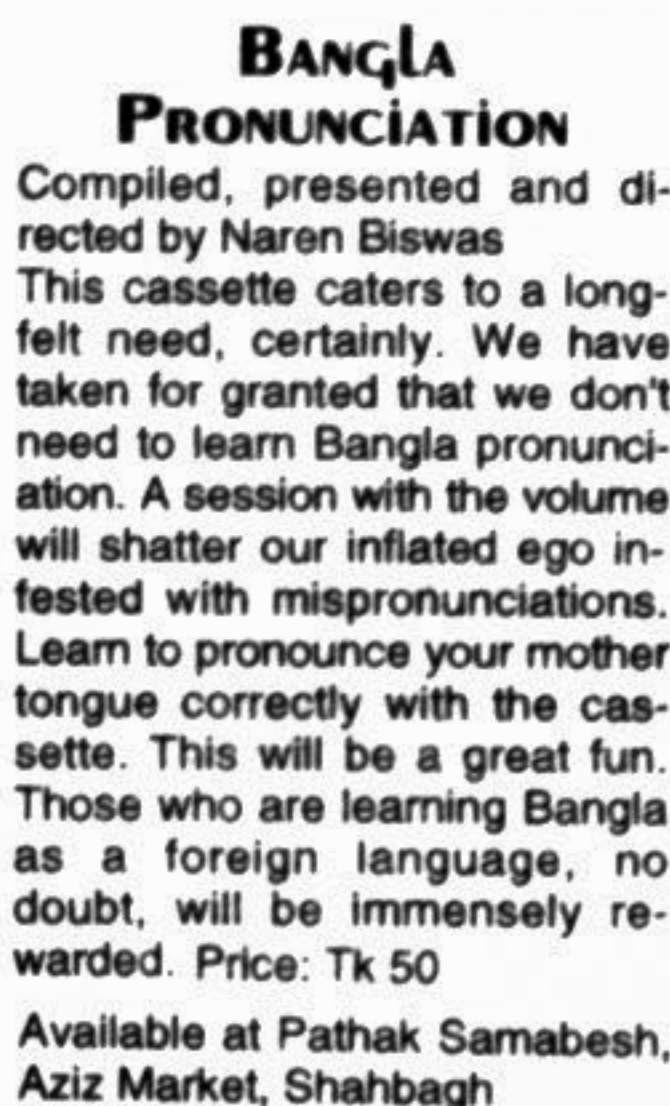
GOURMET GARDEN

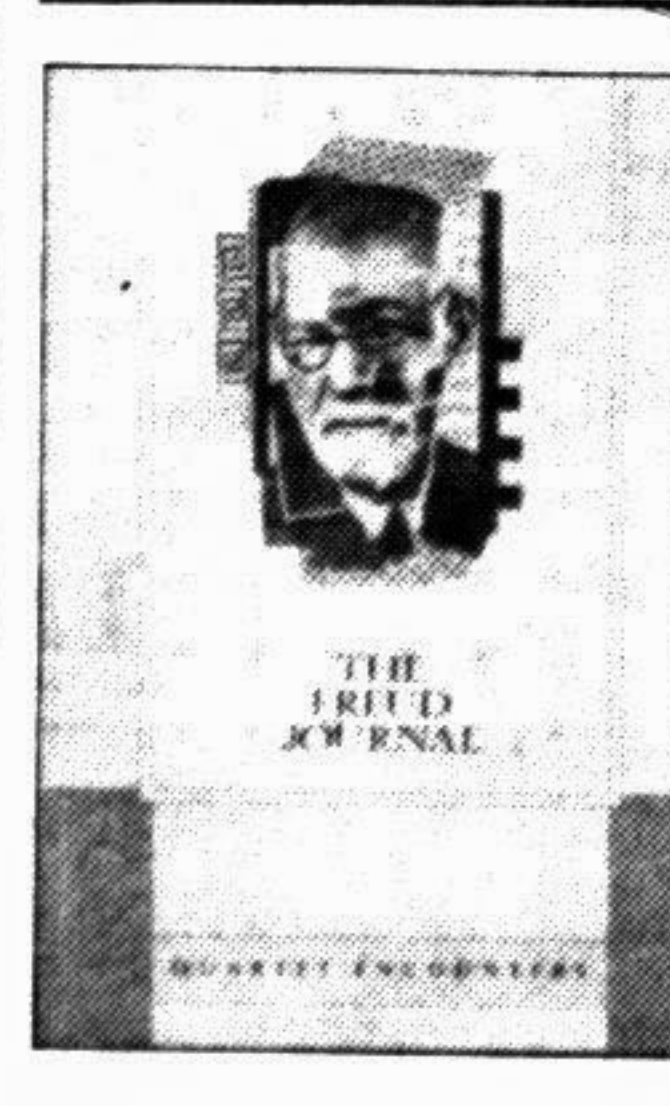
LOVE-LYRIES-LAMENTATION

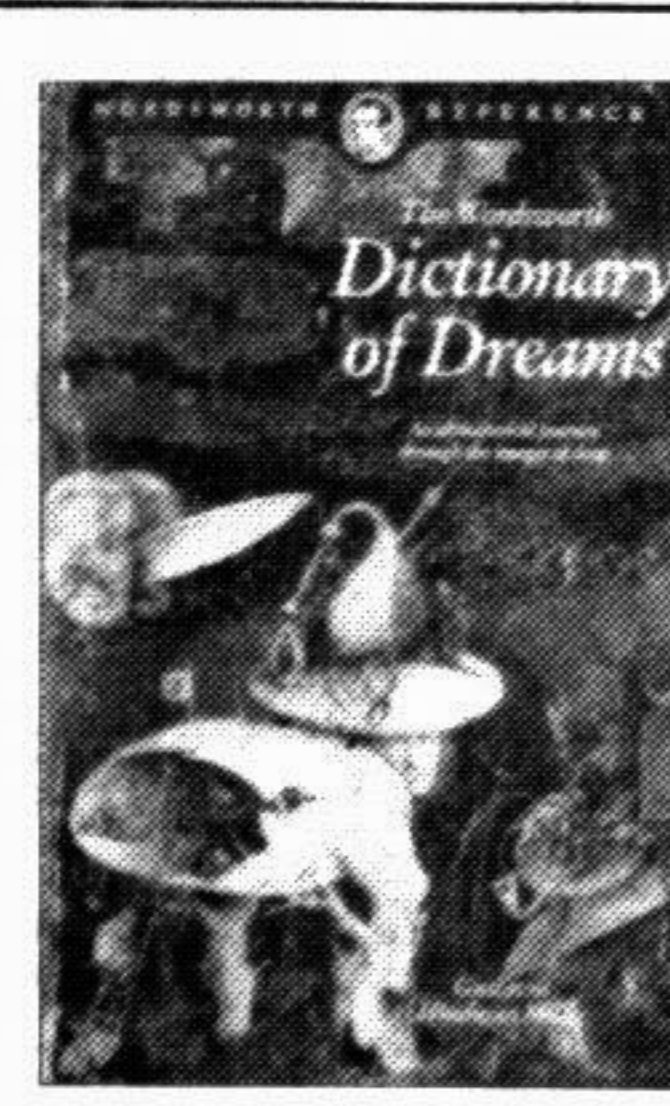

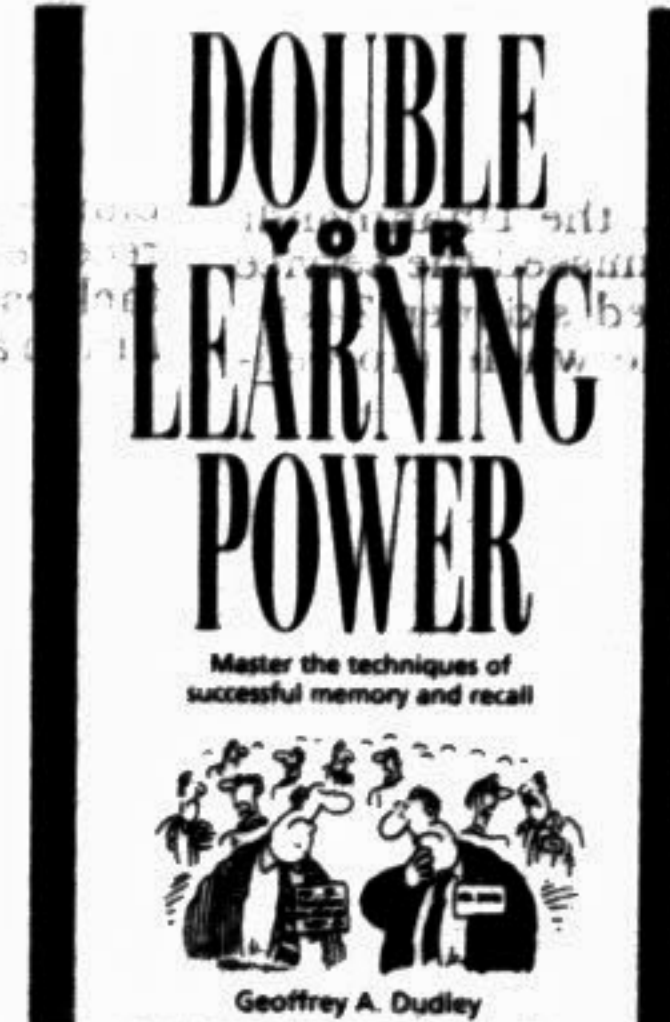
