Belgrade Race Ramaala's

BELGRADE, Oct 23: Hendrick Ramaala for South Africa held off a fierce challenge from Kenyan Paul Tergat to win the second edition of the Belgrade Race through history in the Serbian capital on Wednesday, reports Reuters.

Ramaala won the six-kilometre race around the 2,300-year-old Belgrade fortress in 17 minutes and 19 seconds after a great sprint finish involving Tergat, Luis Jesus of Portugal, Jan Pesava of the Czech Republic and Jimmy Muindi of Kenya.

Ramaala, a qualified lawyer from Johannesburg, has come into his own in the last few weeks with victories in the Great North Run, and in the Rennes 10km last weekend. "It was a good race, very close," he said. "I thought Paul was going to win. My plan was to sit in the pack until the long straight and I saw my chance and went full out."

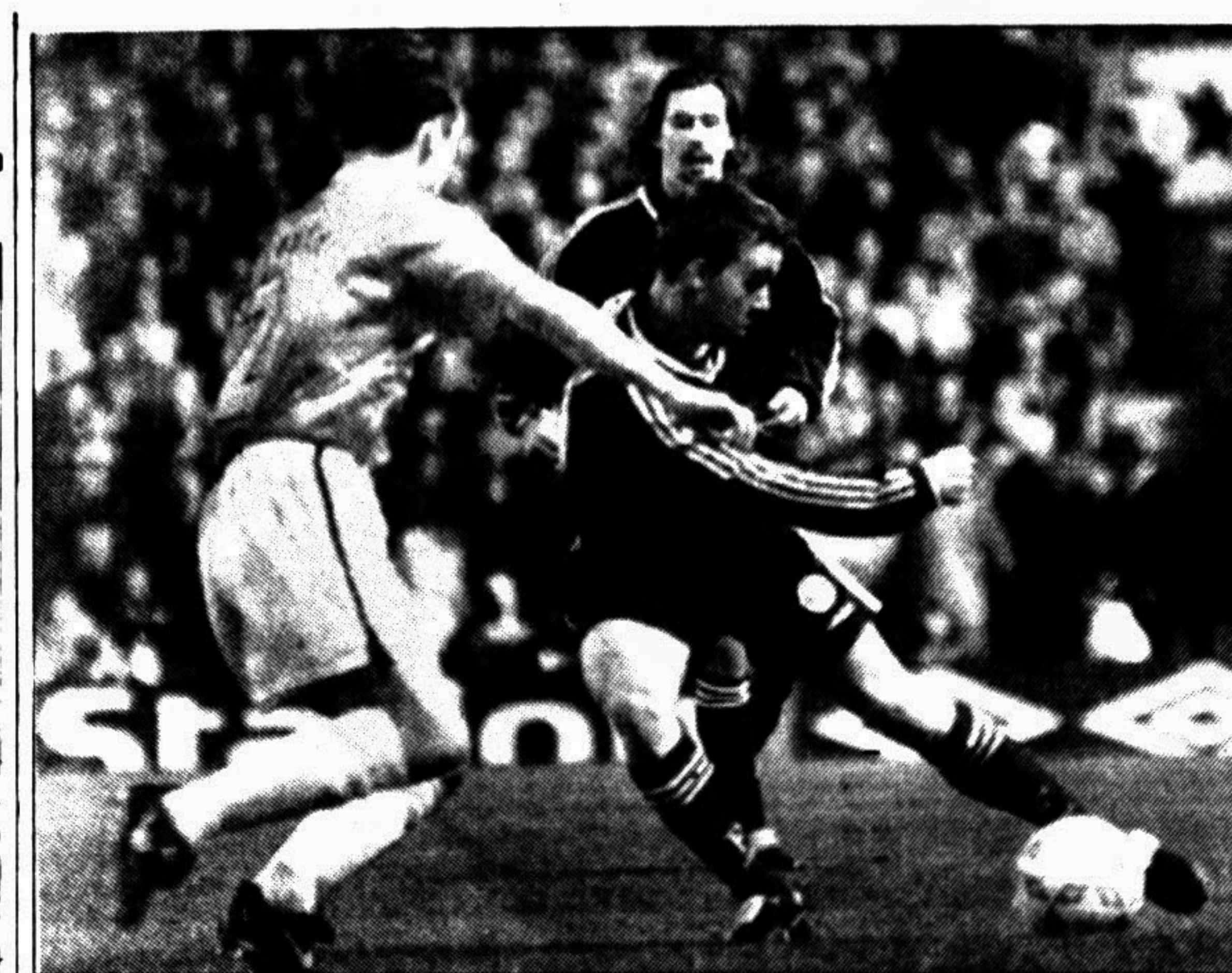
Luis Jesus took second in 17:20 with Tergat third in 17:22 and Pesava fourth in 17:23.

Barcelona's dream fading

LONDON, Oct 23: Barcelona's hopes of reaching the later stages of the European Champions' League knockout competition were dealt a blow on Wednesday after the Spanish side lost 3-0 at Dynamo Kiev, reports Reuters.

While three other former winners — Real Madrid, Bayern Munich and Manchester United — all claimed their third successive victories, the 1992 champions suffered their second defeat in three games in Group C.

Defending champions Borussia Dortmund went down to their first defeat of the campaign, 1-0 at Parma.

With only the group winners and two of the six runners-up advancing to the quarterfinals, Barcelona are already six points behind Kiev at the halfway point of the six-match group stage.

Serhiy Rebrov and Yuri Maximov had the Ukrainians two up by halftime and it was all over for the Spanish league leaders when goalkeeper Ruud Hesp was sent off after an hour. Yuri Kalitvintsev added the third three minutes later.

PSV Eindhoven, who beat Newcastle 1-0 with a goal by Wim Jonk, join the English team on four points with Barcelona adrift on one.

Even worse for Barca is the fact that their great rivals Real Madrid seem poised to qualify from Group D after a 5-1 home win over Greek club Olympiakos.

After falling behind early, Madrid hit back with two penalties from Davor Suker and goals by Fernando Morientes, Victor and Roberto Carlos to move to a maximum nine points.

Rosenberg are second on six after a revenge 2-0 victory over Porto in Norway with goals from Sigurd Rushfeldt and Harald Martin Brattbakk.

It was the third successive defeat for the Portuguese side, who did the double over Rosenborg last season en route to qualifying with five wins and a draw, and ends their interest in this season's competition.

Bayern Munich posted an impressive 5-1 home success over their main Group E rivals Paris St Germain.

An early goal by Brazilian Giovane Elber and two from Carsten Jancker had Bayern clear. Marco Simone briefly reduced the deficit before Thomas Helmer and Elber again completed the rout.

Bayern also moved to maximum nine points, with Turkey's Besiktas second on six after a superb 1-0 victory over IFK Gothenburg. Zlatko Yankov delicately chipping the goal after just six minutes. PSG have three with the Swedes still pointless.

Manchester United became the third team to claim maximum points when they beat Feyenoord 2-1 at Old Trafford.

Indian oldies win the series

AHMEDABAD, Oct 23: India recorded an exciting eight-run victory over Pakistan to go 3-0 up in the five-match Zandhu Balm Independence Cup veterans' cricket series at the Sardar Patel Stadium here yesterday, reports PTI.

Pakistan were all out for 148 in 32.2 overs in reply to India's modest 156.

Chasing the target, Pakistan lost early wicket of Zaheer Abbas for no score following a surprise move by Indian skipper Mohinder Amarnath, who brought spinner Raghuram Bhatt in for the very second over.

Zaheer spooned a catch to Yashpal at mid-on while playing the first ball of Bhatt.

But Sajid Ali and Rijwanul steered the Pak innings and took the score to 78.

The two teams will play their next match at Bhopal on Friday.

Computers to dictate future of England

LONDON, Oct 23: England will be logging on to computers in fresh initiative designed to re-establish themselves as a major force in world cricket, starting with this winter's tough tour to West Indies, reports AFP.

The England and Wales Cricket Board announced Wednesday the appointment of computer whizzkid Nick Slade, who will spend next 12 months assembling a comprehensive dossier on the performances of England and their opponents.

It is the latest step in the behind the scenes revolution begun by coach David Lloyd, who introduced the innovative use of uplifting music, slogans and videos after he was appointed last year.

A similar system is already used by Queensland coach John Buchanan and the South African cricket board and should help England in their attempt to rise up the world rankings.

Before the leave for the Caribbean on January 2, each England player's performance from the Ashes series will be analysed alongside every member of the West Indies team during the series in Australia last winter.

Similar analysis will be carried out in preparation for next summer's series against South Africa, utilising footage of England in the West Indies and South Africa in Pakistan.

"Understanding our own strong points and also our weaknesses will help us greatly in our preparation," stressed Lloyd, who will take squads for the senior tour to West Indies, the A tour to Kenya and Sri Lanka and to the one-day party in Sharjah.

"Knowing those of our opponents will help us find ways to exploit and shortcomings and control their strengths. Having this information available will be a tremendous benefit to the team."

Raymond stays on course

QUEBEC CITY, Oct 23: Second seed and defending champion Lisa Raymond needed three sets to hold off stubborn Italian Francesca Lubiani in a second round match at the Bell Challenge on Wednesday, reports Reuters.

The 15th ranked Raymond, who last week became only the fourth player this year to defeat world number one Martina Hingis, looked like she would win easily when she got off to a 6-3, 2-0 start.

But the 69th-ranked Lubiani battled back forcing the American to go the distance for a 6-3, 6-7, 6-4 victory.

Raymond, who received a first round bye, said she expected a difficult personal challenge in maintaining her level of play at the scene of her first WTA Tour title.

In other second round matches top seed Brenda Schultz McCarthy of the Netherlands and fifth-seeded American Chanda Rubin easily dismissed Canadian opponents.

But American qualifier Jo-ellen Watson upset sixth-seeded compatriot Amy Frazier 6-3, 2-6, 6-4.
