Outlawed party activists to work on hire

Hectic preparations on for UP polls in S-W districts

JESSORE, Oct 26: Hectic preparations are going on by intending candidates in 10 districts of south-western zone following announcement of Union Parishad (UP) elections scheduled.

Chairman and ward member candidates have started contacting with voters. They are trying day and night to mould public opinion in favour of their support.

When the political situation is warming up in rural areas, emergence of outlawed parties in certain areas of this zone is also being reported.

They are reorganising their groups and consolidating position on the eve of Union Parishad election. They are now active in the field with strategy to dictate the election campaign. This way they will earn a huge amount of money.

In certain pockets, terrorists or outlawed party activists are still very powerful. Before elections these groups have become determined to regain their supremacy to command local people. Accordingly outlawed party leaders have been recruiting fresh activists from unemployed youths. They have already created terror in the area by committing several major violence and terrorist activities. Police have been hunting them.

According to latest report, these groups are bargaining with candidates to dictate terms of contract for their work in the election. Their policy is nothing new, but to work on hire as they did in all previous elections.

There are some areas in this zone, where social and political decision are controlled by these terrorist groups. According to source of police intelligence, crackdown by police on these terrorists is essential in certain areas. Police

want to pick them up well before the UP election so that election is held fairly, impartially and peacefully.

A source very close to terrorist groups told that they worked on hire for many candidates in these areas in Union Parishad elections held in 1992 violating instructions of their high command.

Biplobi Communist Party (ML) and Purba Banglar Communist Party (ML) instructed their workers at field level to remain quite neutral during last elections and not to work for any candidate. Later Biplobi Communist Party expelled a number of their workers from the party for violating instructions.

In last parliament election held in 1996 many workers of this party worked for candidates as expected that they would work in this election in their usual style.

Divisions and sub-divisions among these groups have made it clear that they would go on hire this year for money. It may be noted here, that these groups are isolated, they have no leader and none to control them.

Biplobi Communist Party has issued instructions to its workers to remain silent in the coming Union Parishad elections. How far it will be carried out is a question to observe.

It is reported that a defected group of Biplobi Communist Party has begun to finalise talks with candidates about their remunerations in Jessore and Jhenaidah. They have proposed their willingness to work in the coming Union Parishad election for candidates on suitable and attractive terms.

Purba Banglar Communist Party is virtually divided in three groups. Tapan group and Haider group have lent support to two major political parties as before.

Another group headed by Lantu is looking for candidates elsewhere in the area. No instruction has yet been received from Purba Banglar Communist Party command to their workers.

Hasan group and Sharitul group in Jessore and a terrorist group of Salikha in Jessore - Magura have compromised. They will exert their influence in their respective areas and they will not disturb each other during this election.

Lalon group defecting from Biplobi Communist Party (ML) is working for some chairman candidates, in eastern part of Kaliganj and Shalika thanas. Bidhan group of Jhenaidah, Siddik group of Salokupa, Montu group of Harinakundu.

Separate incidents claim 2 lives in Rajshahi

RAJSHAHI, Oct 26: Two persons including a minor boy were killed and eight other injured in two separate incidents on Tuesday.

One person was killed and eight others were injured when a Chapal Nawabganj bound BRTC bus and a tempo collided head-on at Haripur in the city.

The dead was identified as Selina Pervin, 27. Seriously injured Hanufa, 45, Sultana Razia, 20, Shahidul Islam, 30, and Anwarul Huque, 35, were admitted into Rajshahi Medical College Hospital (RMCH).

A boy Abu Shahin, 7, was burnt to death when fire broke out in his house on Tuesday morning at village Shahapara under Bagmara thana.

Two separate cases were filed.

4 police men suspended

KUSHTIA, Oct 26: One Habildar and four constables of Kushtia thana have been suspended on charge of negligence of duty.

Police source said, Biplob, son of Jahangir Ali of Arupara was arrested for possessing illegal arms. On the day of the incident Biplob talked with his relatives for a long time. He was not band-cuffed at that time. He took the opportunity to flee away. On receiving information Police Super of Kushtia took action immediately on Thursday and closed 5 police men including Habildar Abdus Salam. He put them under suspension.

Headmaster's death in road accident sparks tension

TANGAIL, Oct 26: A teacher was killed in a tragic road accident in the district town on Dhaka-Mymensingh highway on Monday, reports UNB.

Witnesses said Topotosh Chakrabarty, 58, headmaster of Shibnath High School of the town, died when a speeding truck hit him in the front of Sonali Bank's women branch in the morning.

The accident occurred while Chakrabarty, a resident of Akur Takur of the town, was doing morning walk along with his associates.

A pall of gloom spread in the town as death news spread. The student-people put barricade disrupting traffic movement till 2 pm on Tangail-Dhaka road.

Undertrial prisoner dies at hospital

KISHOREGANJ, Oct 26: An undertrial prisoner of the district jail died at the Sadar hospital early today, reports UNB. Jail super M Abdul Mannan Khan said prisoner Wazed, 35, who was arrested on October 10, 1996 on charges of stealing, was rushed to hospital at 5.05 am following chest pain and died there at 5.15 am.

Road accidents claim three in 3 dists

At least three people were killed and 25 others were injured in three road accidents across the country on Monday, report agencies. In Comilla, two unidentified passengers were killed on the spot when a truck overturned on the Dhaka-Chittagong Highway.

According to police, the truck skidded off the road as its driver lost control over the steering. The accident occurred at Falgunkara, one kilometre from Choudhagram thana headquarters. Police seized the truck but the driver managed to escape.

Scarcity of water in Madaripur

MADARIPUR, Oct 26: Scarcity of drinking water has turned acute in the district as 446 tubewells remained out of order for a long time, reports UNB. Local leaders said the tubewells went out of order in 58 unions of the district and people are forced to take contaminated pond and canal water. Of the tubewells, 149 remained inoperative in Kalkini, 120 in Shubchar, 95 in Rajoir and 82 in Sadar thanas. The villagers urged the concerned authorities to repair the disordered tubewells in emergency basis to ensure supply of pure water.

BCL sweeps Matlab College union poll

CHANDPUR, Oct 26: Pro Awami League Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) swept the student union election of Matlab Degree College here on Saturday, reports UNB.

Mohammad Ataur Rahman and Mohammad Rahmat Ullah Chowdhury of BCL panel have been elected as the vice president and the general secretary respectively. BCL bagged 12 posts while JCD got the rest seven in the student union election which was also participated by Jatitya Chhatra Samaj.

New Monohordi thana JP body

NARSINGDI, Oct 26: Naziruddin Ahmed has been made president and Kamal Ahmed general secretary of the Monohordi thana committee of Jatitya (JP), reports UNB.

The committee was formed at a biennial conference of JP thana unit held at Monohardi Girls' High School premises on Thursday. Former chairman of Zila Parishad and member of the central committee Mohammad Shahjahan Sajju attended the conference as chief guest. President of district JP Abul Hayat Sarkar inaugurated it with convener of the conference preparation committee Naziruddin Ahmed in the chair.

Plan to set up more power stations

KHULNA, Oct 26: Minister for Energy and Mineral Resources Lieutenant General (ret'd) Nooruddin Khan said here that the present government has taken realistic programme to set up power stations both at the public and private sectors to cope with the increasing power demand, reports BSS.

The minister said this during his visit to the 100-megawatt under barge-mounted construction power plant site on the bank of the river Bhairab. The power plant is being set up in private sector by the Khulna Power Company Limited.

Khan said power generation is both time-consuming and expensive. So the government, he said, has taken steps to set up barge-mounted power plants for power generation at the private sector side by side with setting up land-based power station.

4 killed in separate incidents

GAZIPUR, Oct 26: Four people, two of them women, were killed in separate incidents in the district on Friday-Saturday, police and hospital sources said, reports UNB.

A housewife committed suicide by taking endrine at Dharpara village in Kapasia thana on Saturday morning. The victim was identified as Shahinur Akhtar, 24, wife of an expatriate. On Friday, Sirajuddin, 38, was allegedly asphyxiated at Dighirika village in Kapasia and Zarina Khatun, 30, died mysteriously at Belhati in Sreepur on Friday. Reason behind the deaths could not be known. Also on Friday, a 40-year-old man of Korhata village in Kapasia drank poison at his residence. He died after he was taken to the local health complex.
