3 stabbed at Rayer Bazar

Extortionists stabbed three young men including a shop owner at Rayer Bazar under Mohammadpur thana in the city yesterday afternoon.

The injured shop owner Emdadul Hossain Jahangir, 25, and two others Shamim, 22, and Khokon, 20, were under treatment at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Hospital sources quoting the victims said a gang of five extortionists stabbed the three as Emdadul refused to pay a toll of Tk 5,000 from his motor spares shop at Rayer Bazar. Police said they had heard about the incident but none was arrested in this regard till filing of this report last night.

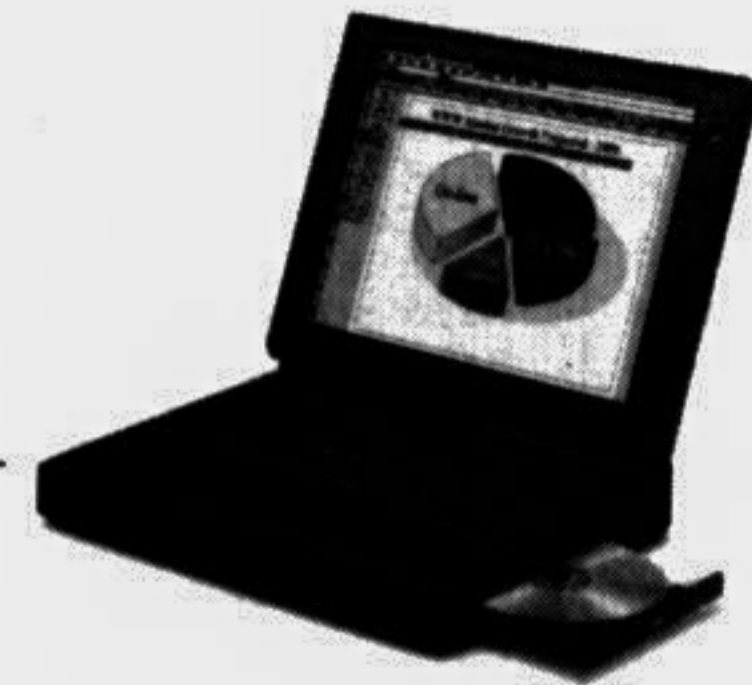
Two rival groups of class four employees of the Dhaka University organised separate processions and rallies on the Dhaka University campus yesterday to press the demands of their respective groups.
