# Change, order of the day

When dreams turned into ashes in Kenya, country's cricket heroes suddenly turned into villains.

Albeit the change of hearts towards the 'superstars' following their success in Kuala Lumpur, a call for a change in both combination of cricketers and the conservative attitude of selectors is nothing new at all.

The success-starved nation which was soaring at dizzy heights following their stirring

ICC (International Cricket Council) Trophy triumph in Malaysia early this year woke up into a harsh reality when the national campaigners hit the lowest ebb in the just-concluded triangular invitational tournament in Kenva.

Unlike the last Asia Cup in Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, as far as status or experience is concerned, did not have to fight against any superpowers of world cricket in Nairobi. Defeats in Colombo were quite understandable and even, to some extent, acceptable as that was nothing but an opportunity to rub shoulders with three Asian giants — world champions Sri Lanka and two other former champions India and Pakistan. But the Nairobi spectacle

was a meeting of the minnows where Zimbabwe, the newest of the nine Test-playing nations. were labelled and not illogically, the favourites ahead of Bangladesh and Kenya, the two newcome: in international cricket wi earned ODI (oneday international) status last

Predictably. Zimbabweans won the trophy, but Bangla-

Syed Ashfaqul Haque desh, who lost all the four league matches miserably, made a mockery of their aspiration for the Test status by settling for the wooden spoon

Kenya, who lost to Bangla-desh in the final of the ICC meet, not only exacted a sweet revenge but also brought the high-flying Bangladeshis down to where they actually belong. The Africans stamped their superiority in every department of the game. In the first match against Bangladesh their openers Deepak Chudasama and Kenedy Ótieno scored 225 runs together to shatter the world first wicket partnership record of 212 runs held by Australians Geoff Marsh and David Boon against India in 1986-87. And in their second encounter, Kenyan bowlers skittled Bangladesh out for a meagre 92. For once there was consistency in Bangladesh's performance. In the previous match against Zimbabwe they were all out for 100 again on a good batting wicket.

International cricketers

have taken the abridged version

of the game to such a height where everything needs to be near perfection. It is true that our cricket has just set its foot on international arena and cricketers require plenty of time to acclimatise with the highly competitive and purely professional environment. But no excuse is just and no criticism is enough for what happened in Kenya. Let alone the sub-standard bowling, batting and fielding departments, the fitness level of our cricketers or the lack of it does not permit them to participate in any competitive meet. There should have been some criteria to qualify in the national team. It seems to easy at the moment. One reason is the non-availability of reasonably good players. And one reason for this air of no competition is because the absence of an integrated and coordinated system of bringing under the spotlight talented young cricketers from across the country. The Bangladesh Cricket Board (BCB) should evolve a system where no player will be able to take things for granted. Otherwise none of the cricketers, who consider their place as guaranteed, will concentrate on performing better.

# Tourists cook hosts' goose


FAISALABAD. Pakistan, Oct 27 (AFP, AP): Pace bowler Shaun Pollock triggered a spectacular Pakistan collapse here today that gave South Africa a sensational

53-run Test victory and a historic series triumph. Pakistan, four overnight, needed 142 for victory with all wickets and two days remaining. But Natal bowler Pollock took four wickets in eight balls in the morning session to turn

the tables on hosts. A holiday was declared in Faisalabad in anticipation of a home triumph in the first series between the two in Pakistan, and there was a big crowd present at the Iqbal Stadium.

But Pakistan were all out for 92 and fell 53 runs short of the South Africa innings of 239 and 214. Pakistan scored 308 in their first innings.

South Africa, who won the series after the first two rainaffected Tests in Rawalpindi and Sheikhupura were drawn, owe a debt to off-spinner Pat Symcox who twice held up the
