2 children killed in road accident

COMILLA, Nov 2: Two children were killed and their mother was injured in an accident at Nimsar in Burichang thana on Dhaka-Chittagong highway yesterday (Friday), police said, reports UNB.
Imon Hossain, 8, and Beauty, 6, wards of Abdur Rashid of Chouhaddi in Muradnagar thana, died on the spot. Seriously injured Jaheda was rushed to a local hospital. The mishap occurred when a Dhaka-bound passenger bus hit the victims at about 12 noon while they were crossing the road. Police seized the bus but its driver managed to flee away.

AL workers urged to organise peasants

NATORE, Nov 2: State Minister for Land Rashed Mosharaf has said the only tested friend of farmers community was Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, reports UNB.

Tk 1.8 cr water supply project taken

BHOLA, Nov 2: Public Health and Engineering Department (PHED) has taken up a project to ensure supply of pure water in Lalmoan and Charfasion pourashavas costing Tk 1.8 crore during the current fiscal year, reports UNB.
According to PHED, the project, including construction of four pump houses and 16 km water supply line, is being implemented under 18-district Water Supply Project. Official sources also said construction of pump houses have already been completed at a cost of Tk 8 lakh. The total work is expected to be completed by December next. With the successful implementation of the project water supply systems in the pourashavas will be improved to a great extent.

Mother, son get lief term for murder

SYLHET, Nov 2: Mother and son were awarded life-term and six others of the same family were given imprisonment on different terms in a murder case at Colapganj thana in the district.
The Additional District and Sessions Judge, third court, Sylhet Mohammad Shahidullah passed the judgement on Thursday.

The prosecution case in brief is that, Mosabbir Ali, his wife Angurenessa, their children Mukit, Babul, Selu, Liton, Mossain and Rehana of village Naliuri attacked the house of their neighbour Fajruddin and his family members as a sequel to previous land dispute in the morning of June 16 of 1993. Fajruddin died on the spot while the other family members sustained serious wounds. After registration of a case, police investigated it.

Students ransack IU transport office

Most of the student of the university stay outside the campus due to lack of accommodation in the university halls on the campus.

166 terrorists arrested in 10 months in Jessore

JESSORE, Nov 2: Kotwali police arrested 166 terrorists including 73 activists of outlawed parties from different parts of the thana during the last 10 months ending October 26 last. Police also recovered 139 illegal arms and 907 rounds of live cartridges during this period.
The illegal arms included one SLR, 10 revolver, four 303 rifles, 11 pistols, 12 guns, 8 shutterguns, 32 other deadly weapons, during the period.
According to Kotwali police, a total of 27 activists of Lalan group, Anwar group, Nasir group and Borak group of Biplabi Communist Party were arrested. From the Borak group, Borak, Idna, Siddik, Morshed, Aziz, Bada, Ista, Jahatap, Shahidul Haider, Latif, Kalu, Gofur and Abul Khayer were arrested.
Another 36 activists of Hasan group and Harun group including leaders of Harun group, Harun, Daud, Mozid, Mosta, Mona, Baka, Nannu, Nazrul, Khanjahan, Khuda Bux, Shah Alom Osman and Harez

were arrested.
Besides the outlawed party activists, terrorists of Harun group including his brother Nurun Nabi, Moshiar Mizan, Harun, Nizu were also arrested in combing operations led by law-enforcing agencies.
A total of 7 workers of Khayer group including the group leaders Khayer, Sultan, Bulbul and Mintu, were also arrested during this period.
