Kuldip Nayar gets Abdus Salam Award

Free press indispensable for democratic polity: Shahabuddin

President Shahabuddin Ahmed has said a free press is indispensable for building a democratic polity and it should, therefore, act in a responsible manner always keeping in mind the national interest.

The President was speaking as chief guest at the presentation ceremony of the Abdus Salam International Award for Journalism, 1997, held at the Osmani Memorial Auditorium in the city yesterday. Celebrated journalist from India, Kuldip Nayar received the award.

Shahabuddin recalled late Abdus Salam's contribution in the field of journalism and said he was a person of the highest integrity, courage and conviction and was dedicated to his profession, never forgetting his duty to the country and humanity at large.

Focusing on Salam's career, the President said he had joined the Editorial Board of the Pakistan Observer, now Bangladesh Observer, in 1949 and became its editor in the following year and continued in the post for 22 years.

The newspaper was banned by the government on February 12, 1952 and the Editor, Abdus Salam, was arrested for his total opposition to the government's views on the state language issue, Shahabuddin said.

"After the emergence of Bangladesh as an independent country", the President continued, "he wrote an editorial, The Supreme Test", in his paper on March 15, 1972. The spirit of the writing was not properly appreciated by the authorities and consequently, Salam left the paper and began contributing in other papers."

The President said the press in Bangladesh was given full freedom by the interim government just before the general elections of February 27, 1991. "The press wields enormous influence today. It is also held in high esteem in a democratic society," he said.

Kuldip Nayar, in his speech said the Award was the most 'Precious one' he had ever received.

Nayar said freedom of the press had to be sustained and maintained by the journalists themselves. "If they look upon the government to do something in this regard, they would be disappointed," he said adding, "there is no doubt that the press is free in Bangladesh."

Maid succumbs to burn injury

A young maid who sustained serious burns at a house in Mohammadpur on Sunday died at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) yesterday.

Sources at the DMCH said the woman identified as Ambia, 30, was admitted to the hospital with severe burn injuries on Sunday afternoon. However, it could not be known immediately how the maid got burnt.

Ambia worked as maid for about two years at a doctor's house in Pisciculture Housing Society under Mohammadpur Thana, sources said.

Mohammadpur police said they did not have any information in connection with the death of the maid till last night. Hospital sources said Ambia's body was sent to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.

32 gold bars, 30 computer processors seized at ZIA

Customs officials at the Zia International Airport (ZIA) seized gold bars and computer processors worth about Tk 21.57 lakh from a passenger yesterday.

The recovered goods included 32 gold bars weighing 320 tolas and 30 processors, customs sources said.

Customs surveillance team challenged Abdur Rahim when he was passing red channel after paying taxes only for a micro wave oven in the morning.

Later, officials searched Rahim's body and found the gold bars in three packs kept under his belt. The surveillance members then searched a briefcase of Rahim and recovered the computer processors.

Customs officials handed Rahim over to Cantonment police as he tried to smuggle in the valuable goods without giving official declaration and taxes. A departmental case has also been filed in this regard.
