DUTA concerned

They said that while the people of the country welcomed the initiative of the government to sign a treaty for establishing peace in the Chittagong Hill Tracts, that particular political party was creating confusion in the minds of the people.

Judicial admn training course concludes

Chief Justice A T M Afzal has laid emphasis on continuing training for judges for qualitative improvement in the dispensation of justice, reports UNB.

He was addressing the concluding session of the 5th Judicial Administration Training Course for the subordinate judges held on Thursday evening at the institute.

The Chief Justice advised the trainee-judges to be vigilant against social disorder and act in such a way so that they can earn confidence of all sections of society.

Thirty-one subordinate and assistant judges took part in the 12-day training course.

Justice Afzal hoped that the Judicial Administration Training Institute would play a leading role in shaping the judges to meet the challenge of complexities like court-congestion, docket management and court management.

Presided over by director general of the institute Justice Badruzzaman, the function was addressed, among others, by Justice Mohammad Fazlul Karim, ex-Law Secretary Mirza Asaduzzaman al Faruq, Mohammad Amanullah, Law Secretary Utkedar Ahmed and director of the institute.

3007 slums in city, JS told

There are 3007 slums in the Dhaka metropolitan area with about 15 lakh slum-dwellers, according to the latest survey by the Urban Poverty Reduction Project, reports UNB.

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman came up with the statistics while replying to a question from Kazi Shah Mofazzal Hossain Kaikobad (Jatiya Party-Comilla) in Parliament Thursday.

Rahman said the government at present has no plan to rehabilitate the slum-dwellers. But such programme can be taken if the country gets necessary foreign assistance for the purpose, he added.

He said that 130 slum families were rehabilitated in the City Palli in 1990 in order to ensure a pollution-free environment in the capital.

Besides, the Dhaka City Corporation has been conducting a project to improve the living standard of 31,000 people in 18 slums since 1991 with financial assistance from Unicef and technical assistance from the Local Government Engineering Department (LGED).

The project includes drinking water supply, sanitary, primary healthcare, primary education and credit for self-employment, the minister said.
