Fire at DEPZ factory: probe body formed

Bangladesh Export Processing Zone Authority (BEPZA) formed a four member enquiry committee to find out the cause of the devastating fire at a South Korean owned factory in Dhaka Export Processing Zone (DEPZ) on Wednesday last. According to the sources the committee headed by a general manager of the BEPZA will conduct a departmental enquiry to find out the cause of the fire at the factory of Swan Lon Co. They would also investigate if there was any foul play behind the fire which was the first ever in any EPZ of the country. The committee will submit its report within the next 10 days. The BEPZA officials observed that the in-house fire service of the DEPZ was not properly equipped to bring the fire under control at the initial stage. The company, however, was yet to submit any preliminary assessment about the losses incurred in the fire which damaged all 12 heavy machinery for padding and quilting. The fire broke out at around 1.20 pm and continued for more than two hours. Later the fire was extinguished with the help of 4 fire fighting vehicles coming from Mohammadpur Tongi and Manikganj.

Bhawal National Park to be upgraded

Minister for Forest and Environment Syeda Sajeda Chowdhury yesterday said Bhawal National Park will be upgraded to an international park, reports BSS. The minister said this while releasing ten deer in the "deer breeding centre" inside the park and some tortoise in its adjoining pond. The minister said Bangladesh established the National Park on 5,000 hectares of land in Gazipur. The boundary wall will be made strong to ensure safety of the deer and other wild species, she said. Monkeys and ducks will also be introduced into the park, she said. The park authorities have already released one lakh fish fry in the lake following directives of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, she said. "We have also asked the National Park authority to plant more fruit-bearing trees to attract birds and restrict the level of noise pollution for inviting migratory birds from abroad," the minister said. Replying a question the minister said the present government is constantly monitoring the activities of National Park authorities. In reply to another question, the minister said cruelty to the migratory birds would be dealt with an iron hand. "The law enforcing agencies will take stringent measure against the sellers of guest birds on the city avenues," she added.

UNICEF Executive Director visits Manikganj



SI Kazi Rafiq suffered bullet injuries in a clash between two rival groups at Brahmanbaria on October 29 and is undergoing treatment at Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH). He was shifted to CMH yesterday morning. The Home Minister enquired about their conditions and directed the CMH authorities necessary treatment. The minister was accompanied by home secretary Saifur Rahman.

Constable held on charge of entering India illegally

A Bangladeshi police constable posted at Hill checkpoint was arrested on charge of entering India illegally after he was brought back in cooperation with Indian Border Security Force (BSF), reports BSS. A BDR press release said Friday that Tk 41,550 was also seized from the constable when he was handed over to the BDR authorities. He was later handed over to Hakimpur police station.
