The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh have received a credit from Asian Development Bank under ADB Loan No 1202-BAN (SF) towards the cost of the Secondary Towns Integrated Flood Protection Project for 5 (five) Pourashavas and (1)one City Corporation namely Khulna City Corporation, Dinapur, Panchagarh, Kurigram, Habiganj and Moulvibazar Pourashavas. The undersigned Project Manager, Project Implementation Unit (PIU), Moulvibazar Pourashava intends to take up under the same loan different type of works as shown below during the year 1997-98 implementation programme.

Sealed tenders for implementation of the works are hereby invited in Bangladesh Form No 2911 from the enlisted pre-qualified contractors of Secondary Towns Integrated Flood Protection Project, Local Govt. Engineering Department (LGED), Agargaon, Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, Dhaka-1207, renewed for the year 1997-98.

Interested pre-qualified contractors can obtain the necessary tender documents during normal office hours on all working days up to 23-11-97 from the office of either 1. Divisional Commissioner, Sylhet, (only for the work value of Tk 10.00 lacs or above) 2. The Project Director, Secondary Towns Integrated Flood Protection Project, LGED Bhaban, Agargaon, Dhaka-1207 or 3. The Project Manager, PIU of Moulvibazar Pourashava, 4. The Executive Engineer, LGED, District Moulvibazar on cash payment as shown below in the list of works (non-refundable) in favour of the undersigned after obtaining written approval from the respective officers for purchase of tender documents on showing documentary evidence of their pre-qualification. No tender will be received beyond this time and tenders will be opened at 12:30 PM on the same day in presence of the tenderers (if any). Interested tenderers may gather necessary information regarding tender and work from the abovementioned offices during normal office hours on all working days. The tender must be accompanied by all relevant papers and earnest money @ 2.50% (two point five per cent) of the total estimated amount in favour of the Project Manager, PIU, Moulvibazar Pourashava stated in tender documents. The rate is to be quoted by the contractor in proper place of the schedule in percentage basis, both in figures and words. The tender will be considered informal and be liable for cancellation summarily if the tender rate is more than 5% (five per cent) less than the estimated amount and if the tender rate is more than 5% (five per cent) higher than the estimated amount is not supported by detailed analysis of rates of all the schedule items.

Both Income Tax and Value Added Tax (VAT) in respect of cash payment will have to be paid by the contractors as per prevailing rules and regulation of the Govt of Bangladesh. Before starting the all civil works construction materials (i. e. brick, cement, sand, concrete etc) will be tested from the LGED. Laboratory of local district nearby. If the test result is not satisfactory the contractor will not be allowed to start the work.

Glowing tributes were paid yesterday to Maulana Abdul Hamid Khan Bhasani, on his 21st death anniversary, for his long dedication particularly for championing the causes of the downtrodden of the society, reports BSS.

Scores of political, social and cultural organisations chalked out programmes to fondly remember the leader who during his long political career was engaged in unremitting efforts for the uplift of the peasants and the working class.

Present Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina gave separate message on the death anniversary of the Maulana Bhasani recalling his sacrifices for the causes of the poor and disadvantaged group of the society.

Leader of the Opposition in Parliament Begum Khaleda Zia also gave message, paying her tribute to the respected leader.
