

# News snaps

## Timber seized : 2 held

**KAPTAL (Rangamati), Nov 17:** Local forest officials in their routine patrol have recovered about 600 cubic feet of costly timbers worth about Taka six lakh from Nutunbazar area of Kaptal thana in the district recently seized two engine boats, in this connection, official sources said, reports BSS.

Two persons engaged in smuggling were also rounded up in the raid with the recovered timbers. The timbers were reportedly extracted illegally from the government reserved forests of Chittagong Hill Tracts south forest division (CHTSFD), sources said. The arrested persons were identified as Ershad Hussain, 32, and Mohammad Hashem, 27 of Belachhari thana in the district. A case was lodged with Kaptal thana in this connection.

## Wild elephant kills boy

**COXS BAZAR, Nov 17:** A wild elephant dragged a boy from his father and killed him at Jummapara village in Ukhiya thana recently, reports UNB.

The victim was identified as Babul, 10, son of Mohammad Ali, a day labourer of the village. The villagers said the killer elephant, coming out from the jungle, chased Mohammad Ali and his son while they were returning home from a local bazar after selling firewood. At one stage Ali tried to climb up a tree with his son but his poor son was snatched by the elephant.

Later, the animal killed the boy in front of his father and the helpless father had to witness the tragic scene from the tree.

## Soil conservation center opens

**BANDARBAN, Nov 17:** Agriculture Minister Matia Chowdhury inaugurated the Soil Conservation and Watershed Management centre here recently, reports UNB.

The centre has been set up a cost of Tk 1.5 crore to boost agricultural production in the hilly region by ensuring proper use of soil and water. The agriculture minister directed the scientists and officials of the centre to put extra efforts for the development of agriculture in the hill tracts. She also called upon the locals to avail of the highest facilities from the centre. "The region has enormous potentials to attain progress by properly using soil and water," she said.

## Minister visits Ghorashal power plant

**GHORASHAL, Nov 17:** Energy and Mineral Resources Minister Mohammad Noor Uddin Khan Thursday visited the ongoing construction works on the sixth unit of Ghorashal Power Plant, reports UNB.

The Minister asked the concerned officials and contractors to take steps so that the sixth unit of the plant could be made operational before the scheduled time, considering the country's increasing demand for power. The officials told the Minister that they were working sincerely with that target. Russian Ambassador in Bangladesh Eugeny P Ivanov and Chairman of the Power Development Board Noor Uddin Bahadur Kamal were with the minister during the visit.

## Man killed in road mishap

**GAZIPUR, Nov 17:** An old man was killed when a speeding truck knocked him down on Kaliakoir-Nabinagar road in Baroipara area recently, reports UNB.

Witnesses said Kosimuddin, inhabitant of Basondoha village in Kaliakoir thana, met the tragic end of his life while crossing the road. The truck driver, however, managed to escape. A case was filed with Kaliakoir police. Meanwhile, an unidentified youth, who was injured in traffic mishap on Dhaka-Mymensingh highway on Monday, died at Sripur Health Complex. Besides, Joydevpur police recovered the body of an unidentified youngman from the lake of National Park.

## Pre-UP poll clash leaves 10 hurt

**SIRAJGANJ, Nov 17:** Ten people were injured in a clash between the supporters of rival UP chairman candidates in Shuvogachha of Kazipur thana on Saturday night, reports UNB.

Witnesses said the clash erupted as processionists in support of two influential rival candidates met each other near a graveyard adjacent to Tenglahat College crossing at night. The two groups fought for half-an-hour. Both the groups — one supported by BNP and another by AL — blamed each other for the attack. Of the injured, BNP workers Sujon, 18, Habel, 17, Tayeb, 30, Ayub, 25, Mostaq, 45, and Kalam, 20, were admitted to the local clinics.

When contacted, local police expressed ignorance about the incident.

## Abandoned fire arms recovered

**COMILLA, Nov 17:** Police recovered abandoned fire arms and ammunition from Anandapur and Paharpur villages in Burchang thana on Saturday, reports UNB.

Police seized the arms, including a one-barrel gun, four pipe guns and 12 rounds of bullets, as part of their countryside arms recovery drive, that began on November 1. A case has been registered with the police in this connection.

## RU Journalists Welfare Fund formed

## Massive rabi crop cultivation scheme

**MYMENSINGH, Nov 17:** A total of 46,447 hectares of land will be brought under rabi crop cultivation programme during the ensuing rabi crop season in all 12 thanas of the district, relevant sources said.

A total of 16,500 hectares will be brought under wheat cultivation, 3500 hectares under potato, 900 hectares under sweet-potato, 6700 hectares under winter vegetables.

A total of 10,800 hectares land will be brought under boro cultivation this year, relevant sources said.

## Jhalakati Poura chairman given detention

**BARISAL, Nov 17:** Abdul Halim Gazi, Chairman of Jhalakati Poursasava, who was arrested yesterday on charges of theft and attempt to murder has been given one month's detention today.

The detention order was passed by the district magistrate of Jhalakati.

Earlier a case was filed by two boatmen — Faruk Mirdha and Rahim Khan — with Jhalakati PS accusing him of theft and attempt to murder.

## Call to upgrade Noakhali General Hospital

**NOAKHALI, Nov 17:** The General Hospital in the district is beset with manifold problems including shortage of physicians, inadequate beds and other basic amenities causing problems to the patients, reports UNB.

The 150-bed hospital is plagued with inadequate manpower and logistic support. Many posts of physicians have been lying vacant for long.

Some 300 patients from different parts of the district come to the hospital everyday for treatment. But many of them are to go back disappointed due to shortage of physicians, beds and necessary medicines.

As a result, untoward incidents take place here frequently over the common allegation that proper attention are not given to the patients. The patients also accused doctors and nurses of their harassment and maltreatment. Outdoor patients

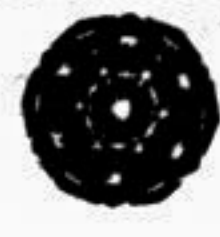
are the worst sufferers.

The gynaecology and surgery departments have few beds and the emergency patients are to stay on the floor for days together.

Logistic supports are too inadequate to provide treatment. The hospital lacks necessary medicines and the poor patients have been compelled to buy medicines from the outside at high prices.

Some few years before, steps were taken to build a medical college here, but it could not be implemented due to unknown reason. Recently Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf announced to upgrade the hospital to a 250-bed one.

Patients here urged the authorities concerned to take immediate steps for upgrading the hospital and provide logistic supports so that they can get better medicare facilities.



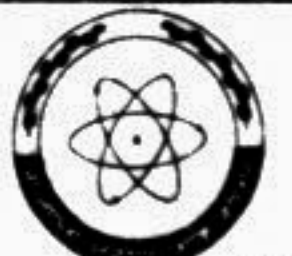
