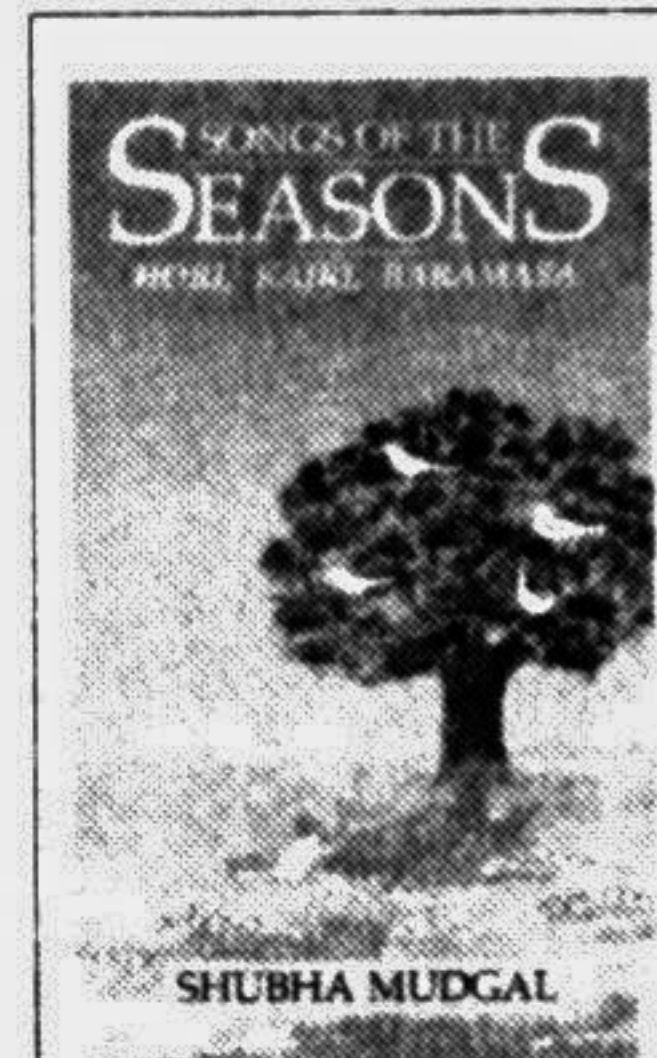
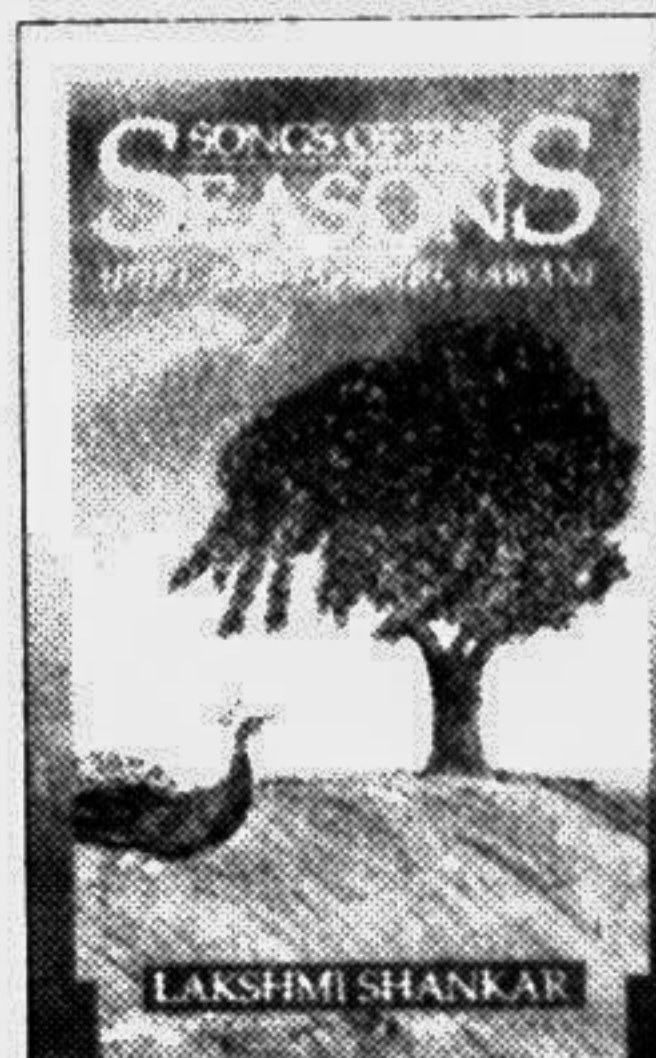
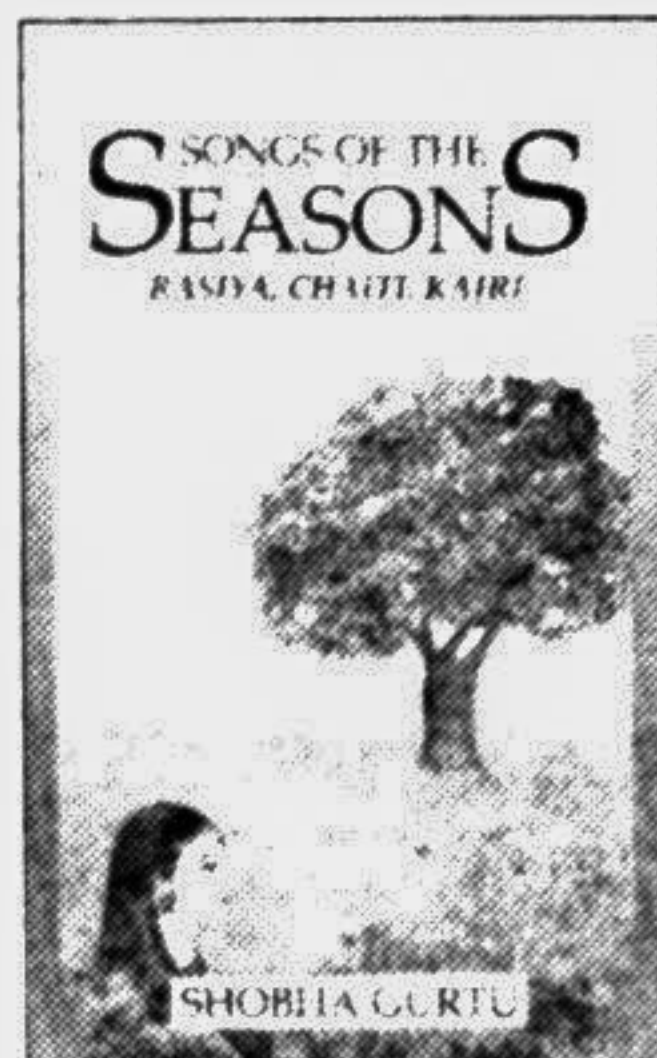

### My Darling CLEMENTINE

John Ford is regarded as one of the greatest directors of all time. He worked in a variety of genres but is probably best known for the many westerns he directed. The industry honored Ford with Academy Awards for the direction of *The Informer*, *The Grapes of Wrath*, *How Green Was My Valley* and *The Quiet Man*. Two of his wartime documentaries, *The Battle of Midway* and *December 7th*, also won Oscars. Ford received the New York Film Critics Award four times and has been the subject of a number of evaluation films, including Peter Bogdanovich's feature-length documentary *Directed By John Ford*. Tonight Star Movies screens one of Ford's classic westerns *My Darling Clementine* in which Henry Fonda takes the lead role of Marshall Wyatt Earp who brings law and order to the town of Tombstone, Arizona, with the help of his brothers and their friend, Doc Holliday. The film's climax is the action-packed face-off and legendary shootout of the O.K. Corral.

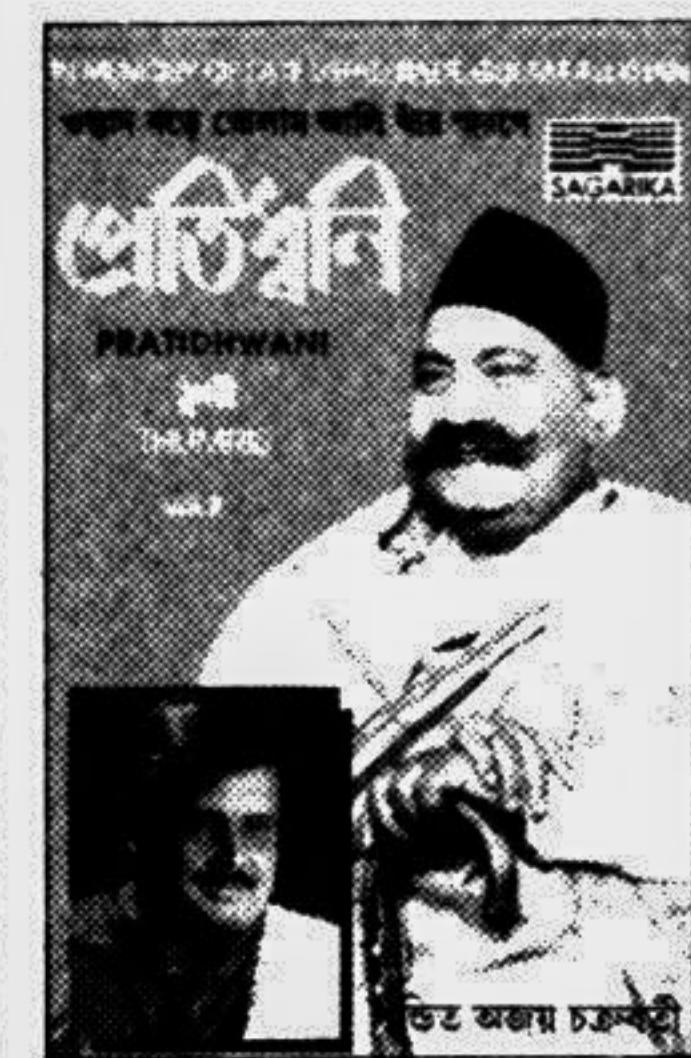


## SONGS OF THE SEASONS (in 4 volumes)

The music of the seasons, a strong concept in Hindustani music, is a result of the Indian musician's association with Nature and the environment. And, in a tradition where the sun has been invested with divine musical powers and is called 'Divya Gandharva' or the Divine Musician, it is easy to understand the evolution of song-types dedicated to specific times of the year. These Songs of the Seasons usually in the Brajbhasha, Avadhi, Khari Boli and Bhojpuri dialects, form part of a living tradition that cannot be defined as strictly classical or folk, sophisticated or primitive in the usual sense. Renditions of Hori, Kajri, Sawan, Jhoola, Baramasa and so on are examples of the spontaneous intermingling of folk and classical genres. Woven into the songs are the physical and climatic conditions characterising each season. Thus, riotous colour, and clouds of 'abeer' and 'gulal' find their way into the Hori sung in the month of Phaguna. Rasiya, one of the most enchanting folk songs of the Hori-Phagun repertoire, generally describes the pranks of Lord Krishna during Holi. The yellow and orange flowers of early spring or Basant colour the songs of this season, whereas the 'Gulabi Chaiti' takes on a rosy hue at times, and at other times carries a whiff of the mango blossom. The languor of a summer afternoon underlines the sensual text of the Chaiti, whereas the Kajri, Jhoola, and Sawan are all songs of the rainy season, and celebrate the advent of the monsoon.

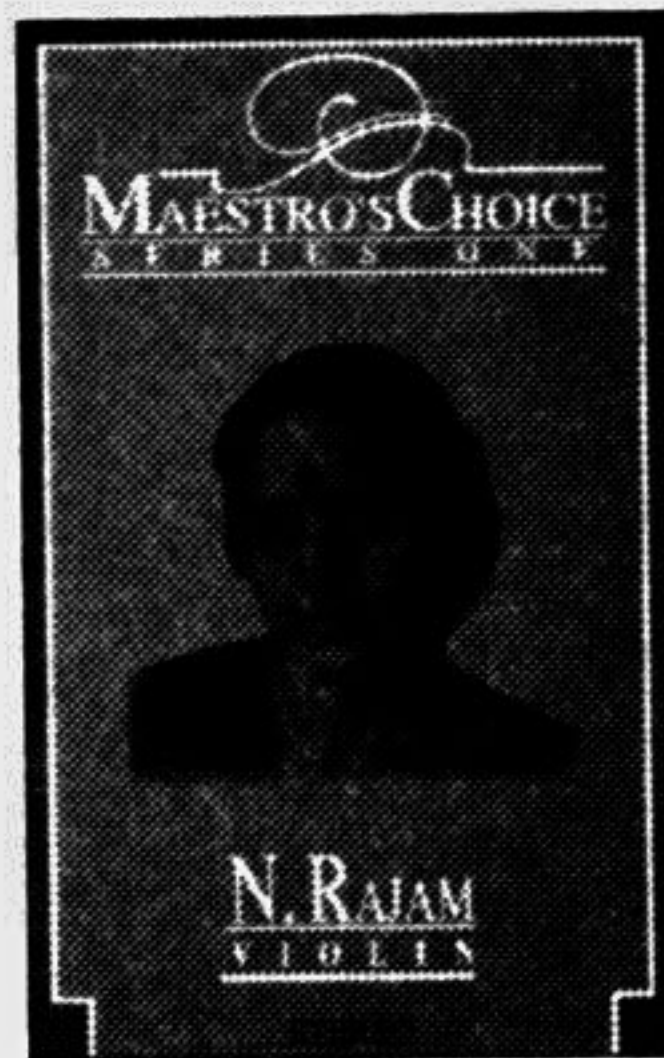

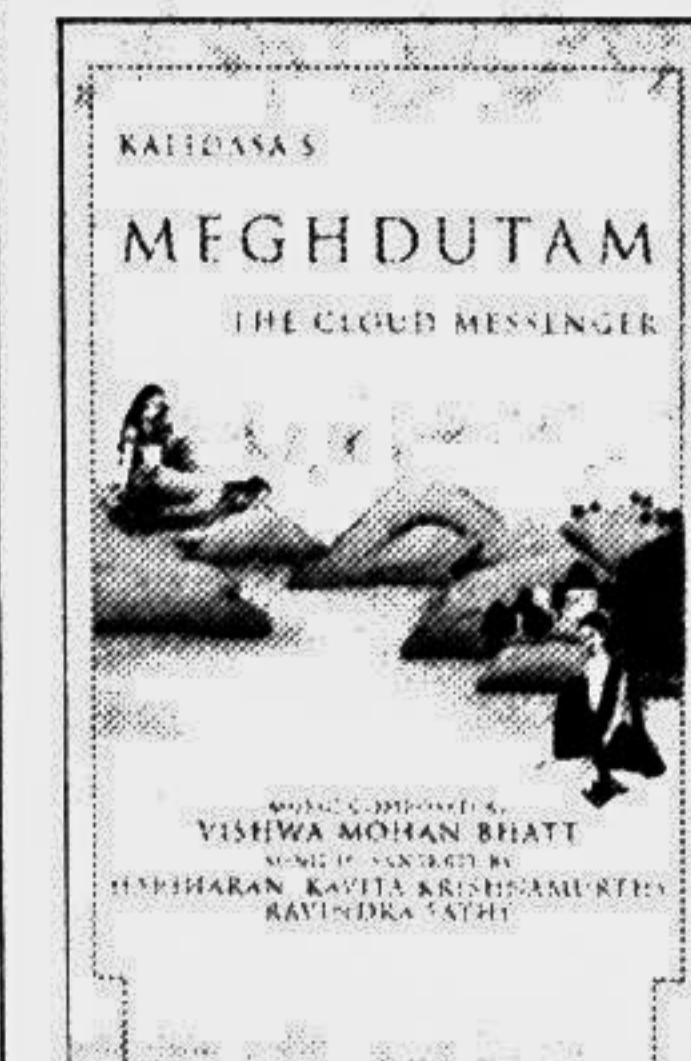

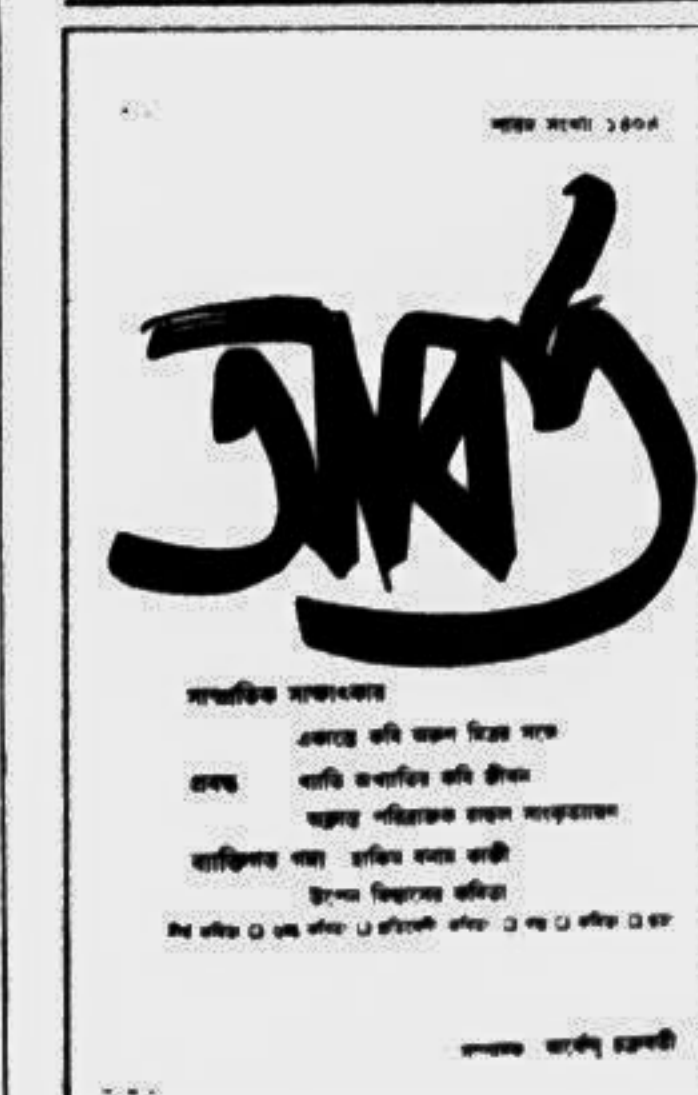
## Food & Drink

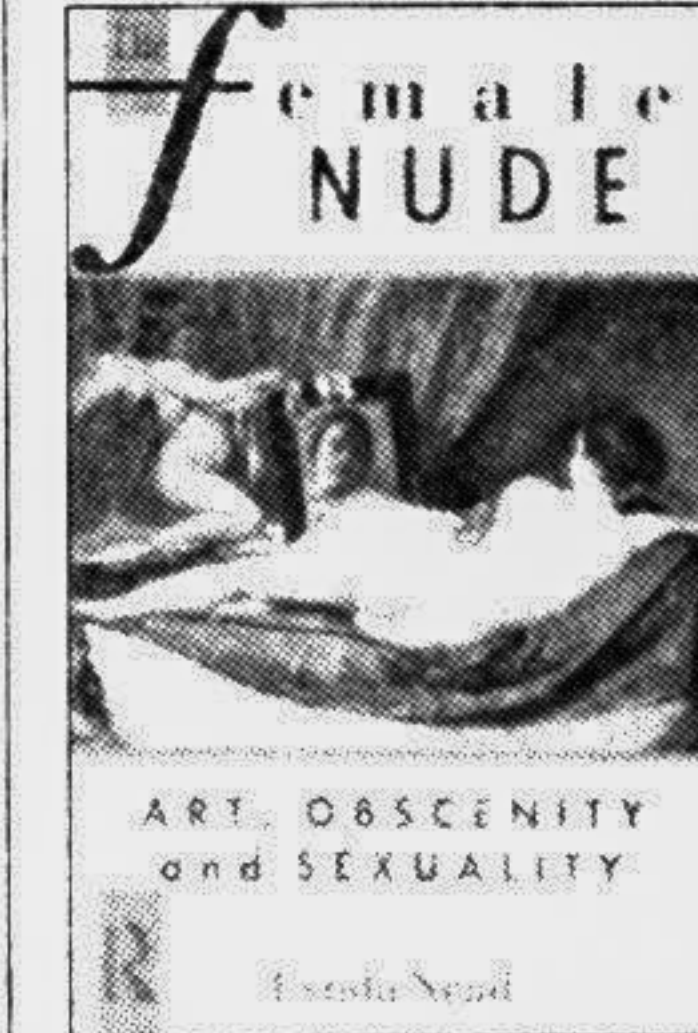

### PORNOGRAPHY AND DIFFERENCE

The graphic genital display, the come-hither look, the spike-heel shoe, and the pearl necklace, lace and leather, are all enduring features of contemporary "Straight" pornography. At first blush, these objects and representations are feminine in their use and their symbolism. They appear marked as (female) "difference." However, this book argues that the pornographic body and fetish object depend upon difference as a discursive ploy. Far from being fixed in symbolic and linguistic otherness, the female models are dressed up in a masculine vocabulary. In pornography, the boundaries between masculinity and femininity are transgressed rather than reinforced.

Can a commitment to free speech be reconciled with the regulation of pornography? In *The Problem of Pornography* Susan M Easton argues that it can. Pornography poses a particularly difficult challenge to legal and feminist theory: at what exact point does the freedom of the individual come into conflict with the legal regulation of free speech? Susan Easton explores and evaluates the arguments used within feminism and liberalism for the regulation of pornography by taking John Stuart Mill's harm principle as a starting point. Given the difficulties of proving harm in the case of pornography, the author turns to the concept of autonomy as an alternative foundation for regulation and argues that incitement to racial hatred legislation might offer the best model for the regulation of pornography.
