

PESHAWAR, Pakistan, Nov 20: Legspinner Mushtaq Ahmed captured 10 wickets in the match as Pakistan humiliated the West Indies by an innings and 19 runs on the fourth day of the first cricket Test here today, reports

Mushtaq took a career best 10-106 in the match as the West Indies were bowled out for 211 runs in their second innings to give Pakistan their biggest of eight wins over the West Indies in 33 Tests.

Pakistan had beaten the West Indies by an innings and one run at Port of Spain in 1957-58, their previous best win over the visitors.

The willy 27-year-old Mushtaq followed up his 5-35 in the first innings with a slick 5-71 in the second, his third 10wicket haul in 32 Tests. Mushtaq bettered his match figures of 10-143 against New Zealand at Lahore in 1996-97.

Pakistan bowled and fielded well to capture eight West Indian wickets for 112 runs within 45 minutes after lunch. Sherwin Campbell offered the only resistance with a resolute innings of 66.

The West Indies hopes were pinned on Brian Lara and Carl Hooper who both failed to stay at the wicket for long, resuming at 99-2, the visitors lost five wickets in the first session.

Lara survived in the second over of the day when Mushtaq dropped him at gully off Wasim Akram without any addition to his overnight 36. Lara failed to keep a drive down but sighed a relief when the catch was

dropped. Lara's delight was short lived as he was trapped in front of the wicket by Azhar Mahmood, a sharp inswinger hit Lara on the front pad and umpire David Shepherd upheld the appeal, Lara made 37 with eight

Campbell held the fort with some subtle batting and completed his 10th half-century in 181 minutes with seven fours.


"I am delighted at this win and this was due to a combined team effort and hopefully we would keep this form in the remaining matches." Pakistan captain Wasim Akram said, "Adding the win would certainly release some pressure after our poor show in the golden jubilee one-day tourna-

Hooper started well hitting two boundaries and a six off Mushtaq but at 145 he played early on a flipper by Mushtaq and was smartly taken by a diving Saqlain at extra cover,

Hooper fell for 23.

Two runs later Mushtag struck again, sending Phil Simmons back. Simmons followed his first innings failure. falling for one, he miscued a flick and Akram lunged to his right to take a difficult catch.

Akram then took two wickets in two balls to push the West Indies near to an innings defeat. He trapped Campbell and Rawl Lewis in the 55th and 57th over. Campbell made 66 with nine fours in his 231-minute stay at the wicket. Lewis failed to score.

"The significance is that he is the first young cricketer to have emerged from our development programme."
Ntini has played 18 first

class-matches since making his debut against touring England in 1995/96 and has taken 45 wickets at an average of 35.

Gullikson gets a booster

NEW YORK, Nov 20: US Davis Cup captain Tom Gullikson received a vote of confidence ahead of the final against Sweden when the USTA announced Wednesday that he would be back as captain for the 1998 campaign, reports Reuters.

The United States Tennis Association also confirmed at a news conference at the Chase Championships that Billie Jean King will return to captain

the US Fed Cup team for 1998. Gullikson will take world number one Pete Sampras, third-ranked Michael Chang, Todd Martin and Alex O'Brien to Gothenberg, Sweden, for the November 28-30 final.

"They've taken away all the pens so I can't sign my contract until after I get back from Sweden," joked Gullikson, who is now assured of keeping his job.

King, who guided the United States to the Fed Cup title in 1996, is returning to the post after taking a year off.

"Last year was a rest. I needed a break. And thank you Martina (Navratilova) for help-

Navratilova took over as captain for 1997, but the defending champions lost to the Netherlands in the first round. "I plan to bring the Fed Cup back to the United States," said




