Betagi: A thana town beset with various problems

BARGUNA, Nov 26: Betagi, an important business centre of the district, is beset with various problems, reports UNB.

Lack of good drainage system, deplorable condition of roads, paucity of drinking water, lack of recreational facilities, inadequate street lighting, shortage of accommodation and absence of passenger-shed at the bus terminal are the main problems.

Water always remains stagnant with filth and garbages at Betagi thana town due to lack of drainage system. Local people said that the low-lying areas of the bazar go under water even after a slight rainfall.

The daily market is in bad shape for long. The shopkeepers have been facing problems due to lack of space and adequate sheds. They have to run their business at the approach roads of the market causing much inconveniences to the buyers and sellers.

Most of the roads in the town area are narrow and unfit for the pedestrians. Breaches have been developed at different points of the roads due to lack of proper care and maintenance. Even after a slight rainfall, these roads become muddy and slippery and the roadside ditches are filled with garbages which are the ideal breeding centres for mosquitoes.

Shortage of housing facilities are also causing problems to the dwellers. No new houses

were constructed in the thana area for residential purposes in public or private sector. Buildings were constructed in the bazar area for commercial use only.

The children in the thana are deprived of recreational facilities as there is no park here where they can pass their leisure time.

The dwellers are also passing their days in miseries due to mosquito menace. Open and silted drains, derelict ponds and garbages dumped on roadside are the breeding centres of mosquito.

The educational institutions of the thana town are also beset with various problems. There are two high schools, one madrasa, two primary schools both of which are non-government. But most of these institutions cannot run smoothly due to shortage of teachers and educational appliances. Betagi thana has no government college and high school.

The only hospital with 31 beds in the thana headquarters is beset with many problems and as a result, the people of the area are being deprived of medicare facilities.

The scarcity of drinking water is one of the major problems faced by the residents. Not more than 40 per cent of the population here get pure water while the rest use river and pond water.

RAJSHAHI, Nov 26: The councilors of Jatiyatobadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), Rajshahi University unit, have nominated a new president and secretary of the unit recently. Mustafizur Rahman Munnu and Taiful Islam Tipu have been selected president and secretary respectively. The annual council of JCD university unit was held recently with Motiur Rahman Montu, Convenor, RU unit, in the chair. Shaheed Ud-din Chowdhury Anny, central president of JCD conducted the nominating process. However, sources said, angry activists of JCD ransacked the 'Rest House' of Bangladesh Water Development Board, the venue of the council, following the announcement of new leadership. The last council of JCD's university unit was held in February 28, 1989.

Slum dwellers get Noakhali pouira loan

NOAKHALI, Nov 26: Noakhali pouira loan disbursed Tk 6.42 lakh loan in 13 slum areas under its Urban Basic Delivery Project last week, reports UNB. Pouiraasha Chairman Rabiul Hossain Kochi disbursed the loan among 321 male and women members in the project area. The loan will be utilised to take up small schemes to attain self-sufficiency.

The loans were disbursed in Shalyaghatia, Joykrishnapur, Mohabbatpur, Fatehpur, College colony, Gopia, Charelahi, Shahapur, Shantinagar, East Majdee, West Majdee, Lakshminarayanpur and Patwarbari areas.

Pouira officials said the credit was disbursed among they slum people to take up small schemes like poultry farming, fattening, handicrafts, embroidery, sewing etc to make them self-reliant.

Loadshedding cripples life in Mymensingh

MYMENSINGH, Nov 26: Loadshedding has paralysed life in Mymensingh town and its adjacent areas. All thana headquarters are also badly affected.

The production in mills and factories has been come down due to this menace present demand of power in Mymensingh and Netrakona district is 42-44 MW while the supply is only 27-29 MW. So the daily loadshedding in the two districts is about 15-18 MW. The daily loadshedding in Mymensingh town and its adjacent areas is about 7-8 MW.

The supply of electricity remains suspended usually 4-5 hours in a day. Sometimes, power goes off for hours together.

The power failure also disrupts drinking water supply. Besides the town dwellers, students, journalists, patients, doctors, nurses are worst sufferers.

X-Ray machines in the hospitals including private clinics, technical and pathological laboratories also remain inoperative for hours.
