

Husband gets life-term

for killing wife

KUSHTIA, Nov 30: One person was awarded life-term imprisonment recently for murdering his wife.

Alhaz Atinul Huq, Additional and District Sessions Judge, First court, Kushtia convicted accused Dulal on charge of murdering his wife Nasima alias Nazma. The judge sentenced him to suffer life-term imprisonment and a fine of Taka five thousand, in default to suffer one year more rigorous imprisonment (RI).

The case in brief is that Nabbar Ali of village Hatas Haripur under the sadar thana informed Kotwali police station on September 26, 1993, to the effect

autopsy and the report said that she was killed.

After that S I Attar filed a case of murder on October 4, 1993 and later it turned into a GR. The judge after examining the witnesses found Dulal guilty and awarded punishment.

Advocate Akram Hossain, APP conducted the case on behalf of the state, while advocate Abdur Rahim appeared for the defence.

Transport strike begins in six northern districts

Nasima alias Nazma was recovered from the closed room of her husband Dulal. Per neck was tied with napkin and in this connection an unnatural death (UD) case was registered with Kalyati police station. On

the same day S I Atiar Rahman along with his force visited Dulal's house and saw the dead body in the veranda on the southern part of his room.

During inspection police identified some black marks in her neck and later investigated the cause of her death both openly and secretly.

Police was informed that Dulal used to commit physical torture on Nasima and on the day of incident the victim was severely beaten and as a result she died. The body was sent to Kushtia General Hospital for
