The declaration emphasised on cooperation and collaboration of the government and NGOs in developing a systematic and planned approach for the implementation of CBR to combat "ignorance, fear and superstition" at all levels.

It further recommended a national plan of action for community level interventions by government and non-government organisations and the government policies must be developed and integrated into existing legislation and implemented at the community level.

The declaration suggested that assistance to children with disabilities through early intervention programmes and in-clusive education initiatives must be given special emphasis

in all development programmes.

It added that prevention of impairment and disability by making community members aware of the causes of disability and by providing access to prevention activities must also be included in development programmes.

Specialised rehabilitation support services for community activities must also be developed in conjunction with relevant community level interventions also came up as sugges-

Effective action research into and evaluation of community level interventions must be part of the development plan, the seminar declaration said.

Reinstatement of fundamental clauses of '72 Constitution demanded

A labour organisation yes-terday demanded of the government to reinstate the fundamental clauses of 1972 Constitution for ensuring welfare of the workers community, re-

The Constitution written soon after the independence had ensured the basic rights of people from all profession and also ensured one's right to be associated with an organisa-

But provisions of human rights had been snatched and reduced through amending and revising various clauses of the Constitution, said Mujibur Rahman, chairman of International Textile, Garment and Leather Workers Federation — Bangladesh National Coordinating Council (ITGLWF-BNCC) at a press conference at Jatiya Press Club.

The press conference preceded by a workshop participated by presidents and general secretaries of 15 labour organisations.

He demanded formulation of a democratic, progressive and timely labour law in the light of 72 Constitution and International Labour Organisation (ILO) convention, said a press release.

ITGLWF-BNCC secretary Z M Kamrul Anam, TWARO president T Takagi and general secretary N Suzuki were present at the conference.

ITGLWF-BNCC will observe the World Human Rights Day on December 10 and has chalked out a week-long programme from today.
