

Police rifle, ballot papers, boxes snatched away

UP polls violence in districts :
2 policemen wounded, 13 held

JAMALPUR, Dec 12: Supporters of a defeated UP chairman candidate have snatched a police rifle, ballot papers and boxes from a centre in Dewan-ganja thana of the district, reports UNB.

Officials said voting in seven

unions of the thana was held peacefully on Wednesday, but the trouble erupted after the announcement of unofficial results of Chikajani union that left two policemen wounded.

Police said supporters of the unsuccessful chairman candi-

date attacked the Barokhal centre as soon as the unofficial results of the Chikajani union were announced at about 10 pm.

They beat the presiding officer of the centre and tried to snatch the result sheets. The law enforcers, however, controlled the situation.

But the mob later put off hatching lights and made a second attack, snatching a Chinese rifle from police along with 15 bullets and ballot papers and boxes of the centre.

Soon after the snatching, police conducted an abortive overnight raid on hundreds of houses in Chikajani union searching the arms, ammunition and ballot papers and boxes.

They picked up four people — former chairman of Chikajani union parishad Abdur Rauf, advocate Abdur Rezaq, Siraj and Mofazzal — in this connection.

When contacted, district Police Super Sanaullah confirmed the incident and said he was in Dewan-ganja to lead the operation to recover the snatched rifle, bullets and ballots.

Of the injured policemen, havildar Ramjan Ali was admitted to Dewan-ganja Hospital while constable Shah Alam to Jamalpur General Hospital in critical condition.

Another report from Kishoreganj says: Police in a surprise raid on a village in Itna thana arrested nine people from their respective houses and seized three licensed guns on Thursday.

The arrested were identified as Abdur Wahab, Azizur Rahman, Hussain Ali, Mainul Haq, Tazul Ahmed, Tofazzal Hossain, Liakat Ali, Abul Kalam, Izzazur Rahman and Mia Dhar.

Police arrested them following a case filed by Abdur Jalil, a member candidate of the UP election from Gazipur union due on December 21.

In his case, Jalil alleged that the accused fired shots on the procession of chairman candidate Shahjahan Mia on Wednesday afternoon when it was passing by the house of incumbent chairman Mizanur Rahman.

Our staff correspondent from Khulna adds: A group of armed musclemen allegedly snatched a ballot box from Dhopakhal High School centre of Dhopakhal union under Kachua thana in Bagerhat district.

Elections were held here on December 10. Police said the musclemen also snatched ballot papers from the presiding officer at about 3 pm which could not be recovered till 11 pm. The authorities concerned, however, postponed polling in the centre.

Meanwhile, polling in seven unions of Kachua thana was held peacefully. All the UP chairman candidates were found panicky as hoodlums hired from Bagerhat and Khulna towns swarmed the thana headquarters, but could not proceed towards any of the polling centre but Dhopakhal High School due to strict security measures. Meanwhile, elections in eight unions of Dacope thana in Khulna district were held peacefully. No untoward incident was reported from any of 72 centres under eight unions.

A total of 42 candidates contested for the posts of chairman, 364 for member and 105 for reserved seats for women from these centres.

Women were found casting their votes in large number. All the polling centres were found heavily guarded by members of law enforcing agencies. Results of the elections could not be received till writing of this report.

Classes not held
at IU as JCD

10 injured, voting in 3
centres postponed

RANGPUR, Dec 12: At least 10 persons were injured following clashes between rival groups over casting of false votes in two centres in Rajendrapur and Satgara unions under Rangpur sadar thana on Monday.

Of the injured, two were admitted at Gangachhara health complex. Voting was suspended in three centres following rival groups' clashes and hijacking of ballot boxes.

A total of 17 persons were arrested, according to Election Control Room. Voting was postponed in Dhantola, Balatari and Pakuria Sharif unions.

Meanwhile, elections in 32 unions under four thanas, out of eight thanas were held peacefully.

Seventy per cent voters cast their votes. Number of woman turn out was great. About 90 per cent voters came to cast their votes.
