**Increasing violence poses a threat to UP polls at Chowgachha**

JESSORE, Dec 17: Violence and terrorism are on rise with Union Parishad (UP) elections coming nearer in Chowgachha and Shinghajhully unions of Chowgachha thana.

According to information, Chandpur, Lashkarpur, Kayrapara, Bergobindapur under Chowgachha union are now under the grip of terrorists. Their activities have gained momentum. Union Parishad (UP) elections are scheduled to be held in the aforesaid unions on December 27 this year.

A BNP activist Ameer Ali, 24, of Chandpur was picked up from local market by local supporters of AL chairman candidate. He was beaten up mercilessly. He was referred to Khulna Hospital as local Thana Health Complex and General Hospital, Jessore refused his admission.

It is alleged, 2 BNP chairman candidates of this union was manhandled when he went on election campaign.

In another incident at Lashkarpur, nearly 10 persons were injured, four of them seriously in armed clash between supporters of AL chairman candidate and BNP chairman candidate. Two of them were admitted to local health complex. Mizad Kashem were admitted to General Hospital, Jessore and rest were released after first aid.

According to witnesses, the incident took place when both the groups were locked in confrontation during election campaign. AL activists snatched away muke and van from the BNP workers. It was the cause that triggered violent incidents.

Chowgachha thana BNP president Abdus Salam sat with Lashkarpur AL leaders for compromise. A tense situation was prevailing till filing of this report.

In another incident at Bergobindapur, AL workers was divided. One group supported the rival candidate of AL chairman candidate.

Situation in Shinghajhully union is worse. Member candidate Irad Ali of Jahangirpur was assaulted by his rival. Both of them went on canvassing recently.

When a complaint was lodged with the local thana police, the petition was reportedly been lost from there and no action was taken as yet.

Local Union Chairman candidate Ashraf Hossain, who is still chairman, attacked supporters of AL chairman candidate Abdur Rahim of Shinghajhully at his village. He came with his armed cadre from his native village Jogonnathpur (Muktingar) at night in last week. However, the incident was averted when local village leaders interfered.

Again when chairman candidate Abdur Rahim Mollick went to Jogonnathpur for vote canvassing armed group of chairman Ashraf Hossain chased him. They confined him in a house with open arms without provocation.

Teachers of the local high school along with peace loving people of that village hurried to the spot and rescued Abdur Rahim and his men. Rahim was saved from attempt of murder. Ashraf Hossain met thana police and disowned his responsibility.

Lastly Babor Ali Babu, 40 son of Moshirur Rahman under the same union was killed in bomb explosion. Several others were injured at the house of Khalil of the same village at night on Wednesday last. It was alleged that when a powerful petrol bomb, was being manufactured at this house, it burst out suddenly causing this incident.

Khalil is the cadre member of chairman Ashraf. A case was recorded with local thana in this connection.

BNP chairman candidate of this union, who was released from Jessore Central Jail, looks certain to win election by any means. He was charge-sheeted on charge of rape.

Panic was prevailing in the areas. Election campaign at night has come to halt now.

According to opinion leaders, lack of police action was the cause of escalating violence and terrorism in these two unions.

**Polls violence in 3 dists Miscreants snatch away 2 rifles, 3 ballot boxes from police in Habiganj**

**HABIGANJ, Dec 17:** Two rifles along with bullets and three ballot boxes were snatched away from police by some miscreants in Bahubal thana on Saturday, reports UNB.

Police sources said a team of police and ansar personnel who were carrying the ballot boxes of Haritala UP polling centre to the Sadar thana came under attack by the miscreants near Karangi river around 10 PM.

The miscreants took away two rifles along with 10 rounds of bullets. Police constable Nurul Islam and Ansar Subot Ali were injured during the attack.

Sunday police recovered one rifle from a graveyard in Sadar thana. Three people have been arrested in this connection.

A report from Sirajgonj says: About 30 people were injured, 15 seriously, in separate poll violence during the union parishad election in six unions of Ullahpara thana on Saturday night, reports UNB.

Police said the trouble ensued at Rahimpur Government Primary School and Anguria Government Primary School centres between the supporters of winning and defeating candidates after 9 pm just before the announcement of the results.

Witnesses said supporters of chairman candidate Shafiqul Islam attacked the opponents at Anguria Government Primary School centre suspecting that their candidate lost the race.

The authority, meanwhile, withheld the announcement of the results of Rahimpur Government Primary School centre as the supporters of member candidates engaged in clash while counting of votes.

Of the seriously injured, 10 were admitted to Sadar Hospital and five to Purnimagati Health Complex.

Police brought the situation of both the centres under control.

Another report from Sherpur says: Four passenger buses were damaged at Nakla on Sunday during a half-day hartal, called by local political parties protesting the Saturday's killing of two people in election violence.

Two Sherpur-bound and two Dhaka-bound buses were damaged by the pro-hartal pickets at the thana headquarters, witnesses said.

The District administration formed a two-member enquiry committee, headed by Additional District Magistrate Khandaker Abul Bashar, to probe into the incident.

Meanwhile, Jainuddin, father of Sekander Ali who was killed in the Saturday's UP election violence.

**Valuables worth Tk 2 lakh looted Clash over buying sugarcane leaves 1 dead in Natore**

**NARSINGDI, Dec 17:** Armed miscreants ransacked four shops including a house and looted valuables and cash money worth about Taka 2 lakh at village Paikanchor in Borochapa union under Monohordi thana in the district recently.

According to witnesses and police sources a group of armed people numbering 30-35 led by Prof Md. Shawket Ali attacked the shops and house of co-villager Chan Miah at day light.

**NATORE, Dec 17:** One youngman was killed in a clash between two groups of people of Tebaria and Belgharia at Natore Sugar Mills gate on December 11.

According to police and witnesses, the clash erupted following a dispute over buying sugarcane. It left Mukul, 18, killed.

Came-growers, in many cases, bring additional sugarcane in their bullock-carts. They usually sell additional cane at the mill gate. The youths of Tebaria bought the cane from the growers at the rate of Tk 20 per maund and sold it at the mill at a rate of Tk 37 per maund in collaboration with some dishonest officials of the mills.

But the youths of Belgharia put a bar on the activities of Tebaria group. As a result, the Tebaria group had to pay a toll of Tk 200 per day to the Belgharia group.

But the dispute reached to its climax on December 11 when the Belgharia group tried to involve themselves directly into purchasing and selling cane.

At one stage of the clash, Mukul of Belgharia group was taken to a nearby canfield where he received serious knife injury. Mukul succumbed to his injuries at Rajshahi Medical College Hospital. The victim was a Awami Jubo League worker.
