## Injured auto-rickshaw driver dead

The auto-rickshaw driver who was seriously injured when his vehicle overturned in front of Jahangirnagar University (JU) Gate-1 on Sunday, died at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) Monday night.

The dead was identified as Azad Hossain, 30. The incident took place when he was carrying a passenger at around 1 am. Witnesses said some agitating students of the JU chased the vehicle and as it tried to escape from the mob the three-wheeler overturned and caught fire.

Azad and the passenger, Kamal, 32, received burn injuries. Both of them were immediately taken to the DMCH where Azad succumbed to his injuries at about 9 pm. The body was sent to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.

The students of JU had been blocking the Dhaka-Aricha highway for the last few days in protest of an attack on their bus at Aminbazar in the city recently.

## Maid commits suicide

A teenage maid reportedly committed suicide and a man was electrocuted in the city during last two days.

Arju, 19, allegedly killed herself by hanging from the hook of a ceiling fan inside a room of a flat, where she worked, at Baitul Aman Housing Estate at noon on Tuesday.

The reason behind the alleged suicide could not be known immediately. The body was sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) for autopsy.

In another incident, Shahid, 35, was electrocuted at Boro Maghbar in the city yesterday morning. Critically injured Shahid was taken to DMCH where the on duty doctors declared him dead.

## Educationist dead

Alhaj Moulvi Shaikh Muhammad MABT of Kishoreganj district, a noted educationist, died at his Lalmatia residence at 4 pm yesterday. He was 94, says a press release.

His Namaz-e-Janaza will be held today after Juma prayers at Lalmatia BB Mosque.

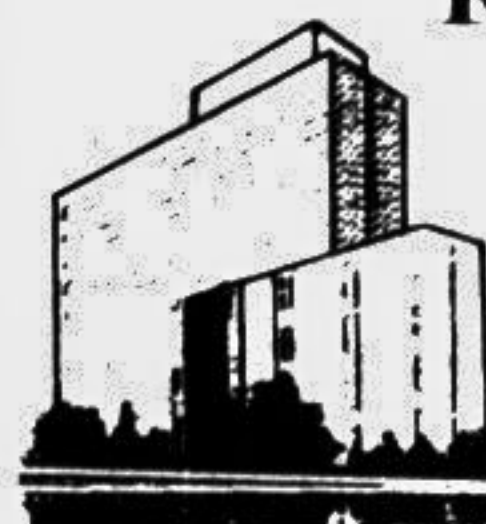
## OCAB night at Dhaka Sheraton
