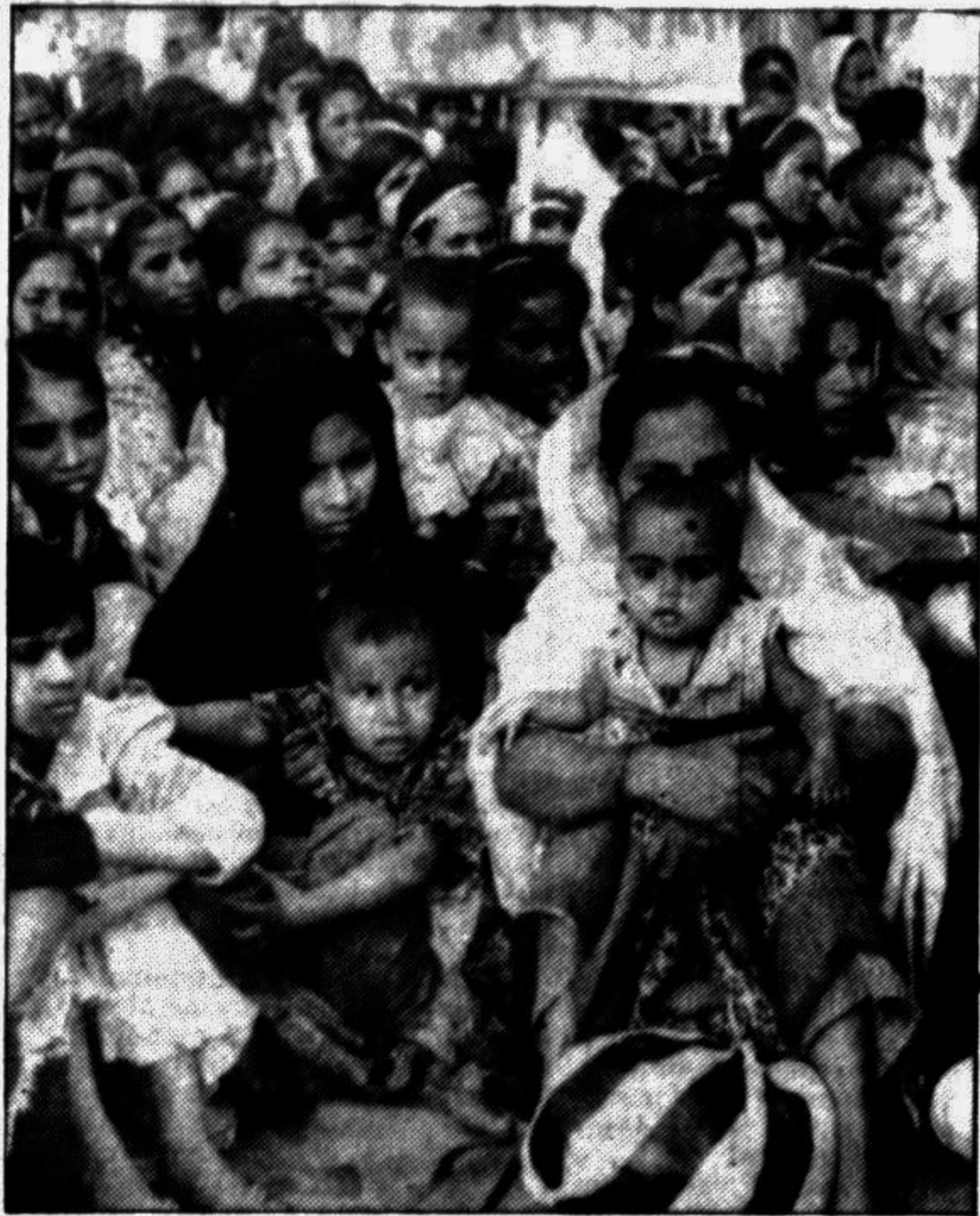

**CHT peace accord to expedite nat'l development : Alamgir**

State Minister for Planning, Civil Aviation and Tourism Dr Mohiuddin Khan Alamgir yesterday said equal status of Bangladesh and human rights of the tribal people have been ensured through the signing of the Chittagong Hill Tracts peace agreement, reports BSS.

The CHT peace agreement would bring permanent peace there as well as expedite development of the whole nation," said the State Minister while addressing a discussion on "The peace agreement — an important milestone in establishing peace in the Chittagong Hill Tracts region" as the chief guest in the city yesterday morning.

Dr Alamgir termed the CHT peace agreement as "The greatest accord in the contemporary history of the world in the context of establishing peace."

He said the achievement has been possible because of the political sagacity, firm faith of the people and unquestionable allegiance to the country of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

The discussion was organised by Bangabandhu Jubo Parishad (BJP) and it was addressed, among others, by educationist Dr Durgadas Bhattacharya, journalist Abul Kalam Azad, advocate Laiquzzaman and Parishad general secretary Rezaul Karim Khan Reza. Parishad president Abdul Jalil Bhuiyan presided over the meeting.

Dr Alamgir said the peace accord has ensured peaceful coexistence of the Bangladesh and the tribal people bringing an end to the two decades of armed conflicts.

He refuted the criticism of the main opposition party and said there is no such clause in the peace agreement which is inconsistent with the Constitution. The peace agreement has been signed on the basis of territorial integrity and sovereignty of the country under the constitutional structure, he opined.

He called for united efforts of the conscious citizens to foil the propaganda raised by the vested quarters against the CHT peace agreement.

The speakers said those who oppose the peace agreement are in fact trying to invite chaos and confusion as well as conflict in the hill areas to fish in the troubled water.

They called upon the people to remain alert against the conspiracy in the implementation of the peace agreement.
