Addressing the function at the commission's auditorium in the city yesterday morning, Dr Wazed urged the scientists to produce isotope locally.

Isotope, the vital ingredient of nuclear treatment, is presently being imported from abroad spending huge foreign exchange.

The new chairman laid emphasis on peaceful use of nuclear energy in development of agriculture, nuclear power, industry and medicine.

Dr Wazed also called upon the physicians and scientists of nuclear medicine division to devote themselves in correct diagnosis of diseases.
