## Dhaka ENT Clinic &amp; General Hospital opens in city

A 25-bed modern hospital with ENT (ear, nose and throat) operation facilities was launched in the city yesterday under private initiatives.

Dhaka ENT Clinic and General Hospital, first of its kind in the country, was formally opened at Dhanmondi in the city by Speaker of the Jatiya Sangsad Humayun Rasheed Chowdhury.

Housed at a two-storey building at Sat Masjid Road, Dhanmondi, the Dhaka ENT Clinic has the facilities to cater major operations and plastic surgeries of ears also.

Addressing the opening function as chief guest Speaker urged all doctors and nurses to work with missionary zeal and welcomed such private sector initiatives in developing health facilities in the country.

He said, "our country has many talented doctors but, there is a tendency to go abroad. Today, if Bangladeshi doctors leave the United Kingdom, the total health sector of UK would be in jeopardy."

With Dr M A Majed in the chair, the function was addressed, among others, by Prof M Alauddin, Dr M Hossain Chowdhury and chief patron of the hospital Dr Shamsur Rahman. Dr Salahuddin conducted the programme. Dr Mohammad Abdullah, an ENT specialist of PG Hospital was also present.

## Trees being felled indiscriminately violating govt ban

Trees are indiscriminately being felled for use as firewood in the brickfields of the district violating the government ban and polluting the environment, reports UNB.

As many as 60 brickfields situated in different thanas of Noakhali district have been using firewood due to absence of coal supply, brickfield owners said.

Moreover, some 20 brickfields have no licence, VAT registration and income tax certificate. As a result, government is incurring huge loss in terms of revenue.

About five acres of land is being used for a single brickfield although there is a rule restricting use of not more than 1.5 acres. Crop production on these land is being hampered adversely.

## Life sketches of newly appointed minister, state minister, deputy minister

## Engineer

## Mosharrarf Hossain

Following is the life sketch of the newly appointed Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Engineer Mosharrarf Hossain, reports BSS.

Son of former MPA late S Rahman, Engineer Mosharrarf Hossain was born on January 12, 1943 at Mirersharai of Chittagong.

He completed his secondary education from Chittagong Collegiate School in 1958 and higher secondary education from Sir Asutosh College in 1961. Later in 1966 he was graduated in Mineral Engineering from the Lahore Engineering University.

Engineer Mosharrarf Hossain played an active role in support of six point demand during the massive student movement as the elected general secretary of East Pakistan Students Union, an organisation comprising Bangali students who studied in West Pakistan.

He came in close contact with father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman while joined active politics as a member of Awami League, inspired by Awami League leader late MA Aziz of Chittagong.

Engineer Mosharrarf, presently a parliament member from Chittagong 1 constituency, was elected MPA for the first time from the same area. He was elected MP for three times in 1973, 1986 and 1996. He was a whip of the opposition in the parliament of 1986.

Mosharrarf Hossain presently representing as members of the national committee on Chittagong Hill Tracts, National Board of Investment, parliamentary committee on public accounts, Privatisation Board, national committee for

formulation of the industrial policy and national committee on water resources. He visited several countries as state representative.

## Prof Rafiqul Islam

Following is the life-sketch of newly appointed State Minister for Energy and Mineral Resources Prof Rafiqul Islam, reports BSS.

Prof Rafiqul Islam was born in a Muslim family on 13 Bhadra, 1351 Bangla year at Krishnanagar village under Jikargacha thana in Jessore district. His father late Kenayet Ali was a teacher. Romeja Khatun was his mother.

Prof Islam studied at Krishnanagar Primary School, Jikargacha High School, Michael Madhusudan College and received his MA degree in Bengali literature from Dhaka University.

He was elected member of parliament from Jessore-2 constituency in fifth Jatiya Sangsad in 1991. He was re-elected in the 1996 parliamentary polls from the same constituency.

A freedom fighter, Prof Islam earned fame for his role in the fifth Jatiya Sangsad and was a member of the Jatiya Sangsad Standing Committees on Public Undertakings and Education in the fifth parliament.

Prof Islam was appointed whip of the Jatiya Sangsad on July 14, 1996 and is a chairman of public undertakings committee, member of standing committee on local government, rural development and cooperatives. He is now minister in-charge of Jessore district.

Prof Islam took oath as a state minister on December 31, 1997.

## Saber Hossain Chowdhury

Saber Hossain Chowdhury, MP, who was appointed Deputy Minister for Shipping Wednesday, was born on September 10, 1961 in Chittagong, reports BSS.

Chowdhury is the third son of Hedayet Hossain Chowdhury, chairman of Karnaphuli Group and Rashida Hossain Chowdhury of Gahira under Raozan Thana in Chittagong district.

He hails from the noted Chowdhury family of Ramnagar of Dagonbhuiyan thana under Feni district.

After completing his school education at St Maris and St Placids School in Chittagong, Saber Hossain Chowdhury went to London, where he completed double honours course in economics and politics in school of Oriental and African Studies at London University. Later he earned post graduation degree law from University of West Minister.

On his first appearance in the general elections, he was elected member of parliament from Dhaka-6 (Motijheel-Sabujbagh) constituency as an Awami League candidate. Awami League took the seat for the first time after 1973 in his victory.

Publisher of the leading Bengali Daily The Bhorer Kagaj, Chowdhury is a renowned sports organiser who is involved with the Abahani Limited for long. Currently, he is one of the directors of Abahani Limited.

He is married and father of a son and a daughter.

Chowdhury took oath as the Deputy Minister of the government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh on December 31, 1997 and was allocated the Ministry of Shipping and Water Transport.
