More relief for cold-hit people

To help the people most affected by the current cold wave in the northern districts, CARE-Bangladesh is sending relief in the form of blankets and Humanitarian Daily Rations (HDR). This operation has been made possible through a donation of US\$ 20,000 from the Texaco and Chevron companies (USA), as well as support from the United States Agency for International Development (USAID). The value of the HRDs is estimated at over Taka 70 lakh, says a press release.

A total of 5,000 blankets and 46,000 packets of HDR will be distributed to cold-affected people of Panchagarh, Thakurgaon, Rangpur, Dinajpur, Joypurhat, Bogra, Nilphamari, Lalmonirhat, and Sirajganj districts. The distribution will be undertaken in cooperation with Thengamara Mohila Sabuj Songha (TMSS) and National Development Programme (NDP).

MCCI

The Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MCCI) yesterday donated about 300 pieces of winter clothes to the Prime Minister's Relief Fund for the people affected by the severe cold-wave, reports BSS.

MCCI president Laila Kabir handed over the clothes to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at Ganabhaban residence today at 3 pm, and at her Tejgaon office tomorrow at 11 am.

Bangladesh Army

Bangladesh Army has donated 7,500 blankets for the victims of the severe cold-wave, an ISPR press release said. Chief of Army Staff Lieutenant Gen Mohammad Mustafizur Rahman, Bir Bikram, on Thursday handed over the blankets procured from the army's own resources.

Meanwhile, the Prime Minister will receive relief goods for the cold-wave affected people at her Ganabhaban residence today at 3 pm, and at her Tejgaon office tomorrow at 11 am.

200 children selling drugs in 30 points of city

Ninety per cent children sell Phensidyl along with other drugs, but 60 per cent sell only Phensidyl. Three per cent occasionally sell heroin and five per cent Pathidrine along with Phensidyl. Other items, the children carry, are ganja, cigarettes and various types of wine.

All of the children, identified in the survey, have the experience of physical and psychological torture by their bosses, police, musclemen. Sometimes they fall victim to the wrath of misidentified customers.

The survey, conducted by Unnayan Shahojy Team (UST), said the children are working for their bosses taking high risk.

Seventy-four per cent of the children attributed their involvement in the illegal profession to the financial hardship of their families while 12 per cent said at the primary stage they carried out the orders of their bosses and gradually got involved in the job for lust of money.

The report said 70 per cent children have taken up this job with the help of their known persons while seven per cent with their parent's cooperation and six per cent by relatives and five per cent aided by their friends.

The survey found the involvement of girls in the profession only two per cent.

The survey was conducted to hold a roundtable with renowned resource persons work on child issues.
