



6-month bans on 3 French booters

PARIS, Jan 9: Vincent Guerin, Antoine Sibierski and Dominique Arrabage were suspended for six months for testing positive for drugs, the French soccer federation announced Thursday, reports AP.

Last fall Guerin of Paris — Saint Germain, Sibierski of Auxerre, and Arrabage of Toulouse were reported to have tested positive for the banned anabolic steroid nandrolone.

They each had a second test which confirmed the findings of the original sample.

The players and their lawyers were heard by the federation's doping commission.

They now have 10 days to appeal the suspensions, which also included a 12-month suspended sentence.

Another player, Cyril Pouget of Le Havre, had his case put on hold pending further analysis of his urine sample. The player and his lawyer claim there were irregularities in the handling of the urine sample and asked for a further genetic analysis.

David Garcia of Lille tested positive for nandrolone in December 1996 and was suspended for six months.

In 1996 there were 28 French athletes who tested positive for nandrolone.

Chovanec takes Uhrin's places

PRAGUE, Jan 9: Sparta Prague's Jozef Chovanec was named as the Czech Republic's new national team coach on Thursday, reports Reuters.

Chovanec, a stalwart defender for the former Czechoslovakia, is to sign a two-year contract. Football Union chairman Frantisek Chvalovsky told a news conference.

His first match in charge will be against Ireland on March 25 in the eastern city of Olomouc.

Chovanec, 37, took over at Sparta last year and quickly led the team to the championship. This season they hold a 10-point lead at the winter break.

The Slovak-born Chovanec takes over for Dusan Uhrin who announced his decision to stand down after the Czechs finished third in the Confederations Cup in mid-December.

Anand forces tie-break

LAUSANNE, Switzerland, Jan 9: Challenger Viswanathan Anand beat defending champion Anatoly Karpov in the thrilling sixth game of the FIDE World Championship on Thursday to force a tiebreaker, reports AP/Reuters.

Trailing 2-1, the 28-year-old Grand Master from India won the four-hour contest after 42 moves.

With speed games to decide the title today, Anand who is a leading exponent of blitz chess, is now the clear favourite to capture the championship from the 46-year-old Russian.

Playing white, he staked his hopes on the Trompovsky attack, an opening popularised by the English players Julian Hodgson and Michael Adams, against which Karpov has a relatively poor record.

Departing from known lines with his seventh move, Anand achieved the desired imbalance when he and Karpov castled on opposite sides.

By move 12, Karpov was half-an-hour behind on the clock, having used more than half the time allocated for his first 40 moves.

Karpov, spurning chances to provoke the position, developed sensibly, and by move 23 had at least equalised. His surprising 24th move triggered a series of

minor exchanges which permitted Anand a significant central pawn advance.

Karpov's inexplicable response cost him one of his bishop for nothing more than a couple of insignificant pawns. Ten moves later he was already defending mating threats.

He limped through the time control at move 40 but resigned two moves later.

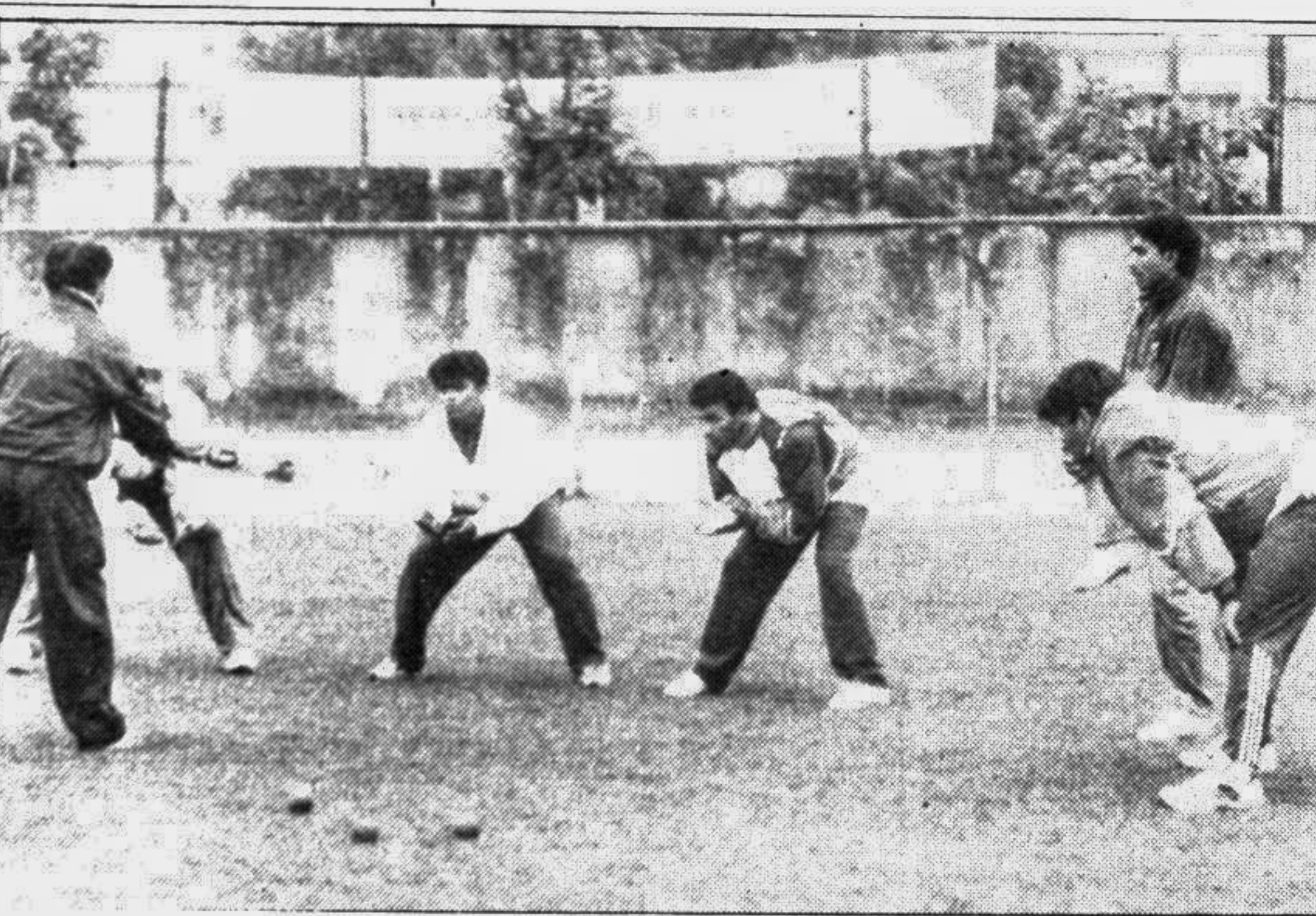
Controversy is now assured as, for the first time in the 111-year history of the World Championship, the outcome will be decided by the result of quicker and quicker blitz games.

Rusedski reaches last eight

DOHA, Jan 9: Greg Rusedski booked his place in the quarterfinals of the million dollar Qatar Open on Thursday with a comfortable 6-2, 7-5 win over Morocco's Karim Alami, reports Reuters.

Rusedski, promoted to number one seed after the withdrawal from injury of Russia's Yevgeny Kafelnikov, took just 67 minutes to clinch victory and a last eight match against France's number eight seed Fabrice Santoro.

English soccer scene

LONDON, Jan 9: Veteran of a World Cup final and a two-time UEFA Cup winner, Nicola Bertini appears to be the ideal recruit for relegation-threatened Tottenham when they face up to defending champions and league leaders Manchester United on Saturday, reports AP.

If only Spurs coach Christian Gross could find more help. Bertini, who played on the Italian team that lost to Brazil in a penalty shootout in the 1994 World Cup final, has moved to Spurs on a free transfer from Inter Milan to join up with his former Inter colleague, Juergen Klinsmann, who transferred there a month ago.

The 30-year-old Italian midfielder, who spent most of this season on the Inter bench with the team atop the Serie A standings, is guaranteed to see action with injury-hit Spurs.

Without stars such as Darren Anderton, Chris Armstrong and probably Les Ferdinand, his team is ill-equipped to face arguably Europe's strongest team, which scored five goals at Chelsea on Sunday to knock Ruud Geulit's team out of the FA Cup.

Bertini, who scored 41 goals in 312 games in his 10-year spell with Inter, should settle in as a goalscoring midfielder operating behind Klinsmann.

"This is a big test for me. I must show the Spurs management I am still the same Nicola Bertini they think they have bought," said the Italian, who helped Inter win the Italian league and UEFA Cup titles in 1988-89 and also the UEFA Cup again two years later.

But Gross has problems in attack, midfield and defence. Frustrated by the Spurs injury crisis and angry that the rest don't appear fit enough, Gross this week tried to buy two more players to improve the squad.

But Algerian international Moussa Saib isn't currently available while Spurs attempt to sign England leftback Andy Hinchcliffe from Everton for through Thursday because he has an Achilles tendon problem.

Now Gross faces up to trying to beat Alex Ferguson's United at their Old Trafford fortress. United have won nine of their 10 league games at home, tying the other, yet Gross will have noted that Ferguson's team lost their last league game, 3-2 at Coventry after leading 2-1 with four minutes to go.

Lying next to last with 20 points from 21 games, Spurs could wind up last if Barnsley win at erratic eighth-place West Ham, who have won 10 and lost 10 of their 21 league games this

season. With second place Blackburn not in action until Sunday, when Roy Hodgson's team visits seventh-place Derby, Ferguson's team, which is aiming for its fifth Premier League title in six seasons, can increase its lead to eight points by Saturday night.

Chelsea, lying third and seven points behind, host a Coventry team which is in spectacular form, beating United in the league and then knocking Liverpool out of the FA Cup on a 3-1 win at Anfield.

Gullit's team, which needed a penalty shootout to subdue division one Ipswich in Wednesday's League Cup quarterfinal, will have to watch out for the mazy dribbling and goalscoring of 21-year-old sky blues striker Darren Huckerby, who netted brilliant goals against both United and Liverpool.

Fourth-place Liverpool, nine points behind the leaders, host Wimbledon and manager Roy Evans still faces a tricky dilemma over whether to field American goalkeeper Brad Friedel.

The form of first-choice keeper David James has been shaky but former Columbus Crew star Friedel, signed for one million pounds (1.6 million dollars) from Major League Soccer, has sat on the bench for four games.

That puts Evans and Friedel in a difficult position because the government likely will take away the American's work permit if he doesn't play in 75 per cent of Liverpool's games before the end of the season. With a maximum of 21 to go, time is running out.

George Graham takes his fifth place Leeds to his former club, sixth-place Arsenal, for what likely will be a low scoring game. Both teams have been struggling to hit the target in league games but haven't been conceding many either.

In other games Saturday, second from last Everton meet a Crystal Palace team yet to win at home, and Bolton, one place above the Toffees, host Southampton.

Kickboxer in serious condition

INGLEWOOD, California, Jan 9: A kickboxer, pummeled with four kicks to the head during a weekend middleweight martial arts bout remained in very critical condition Monday, two days after surgery for bleeding in the brain, reports AP.
