Weather

Dry spell to continue

Mild to moderate cold wave is sweeping over Rajshahi division and the regions of Mymensingh, Tangail, Srimangal, Jessore and Chuadanga, reports UNB.

Met Office said weather may remain dry across the country with fog during night and morning over the river basins.

Night temperature may fall by 1-3 degrees Celsius over the country.

Moderate cold wave may sweep over Rajshahi, Dhaka, Khulna and Sylhet divisions and mild cold wave elsewhere across the country during next 36 hours.

Cold wave is likely to continue, the weathermen predicted in their extended outlook for subsequent two days.

The sun sets today at 5:39 pm and rises on Sunday at 6:42 am.

The highest temperature of the country was recorded yesterday at Chittagong 26.2 degrees Celsius and the lowest at Dinajpur 8.0 degrees.

Resentment over ban on BB trade union activities

Samajtantrik Sramik Front yesterday expressed resentment over the banning of trade union activities in Bangladesh Bank, reports UNB.

Its president Abdullah Sarkar and general secretary Abdur Razzak in a statement termed the January 19 incident as an isolated one and said on that pretext democratic rights of general employees can't be curbed.

The left leaders said an enquiry could be made against those responsible for the incident.

They said banning trade union activities in the central bank was a deep-rooted conspiracy and World Bank had been pressing for it since long. The January 19 incident was only a pretext.

The Front leaders regretted that defaulters, who had embezzled crores of taka of the depositors in collaboration with some corrupt bank officials, were not taken to task.

SPGRC leaders meet Rafiq

Home Minister Rafiqul Islam, (Bir Uttam), yesterday assured the leaders of the Stranded Pakistanis General Repatriation Committee (SPGRC) that he would look into their civic and social problems, a press release of the committee in the city said, reports BSS.

He gave the assurance while an SPGRC delegation, led by its leader M Nasim Khan, called on the minister at his office.

Presenting a memorandum, Nasim Khan urged the minister to help rehabilitate the stranded people of P/60 camp at Khalishpur in Khulna, restore electric and water connections in Sardar Bahadur Camp in Chittagong, reallocate gratuitous relief to 26,000 Stranded Pakistanis of Mirpur Section 11 in Dhaka and to close down illegal butcher shops and slaughter houses of animals in Geneva Camp, Mohammadpur, the press release said.

The home minister listened to the grievances from Nasim Khan and gave the assurance of providing full protection and security to the life and property of Stranded Pakistanis in all the camps.

BARC certificate giving ceremony held

The certificate giving ceremony of a 12-day training programme on Farming Systems Research and Development Methodology was held at the Bangladesh Agricultural Research Council (BARC) in the city on Thursday, reports UNB.

Advocate M Rahman Ali, MP, gave away certificates among the participants. Twenty eight agricultural scientists from different research organisations took part in the training programme.

Dr Zahurul Karim, Executive Chairman, BARC preside over the function while M Enamul Haque, Director General, Department of Agricultural Extension and Liaquat Ali, Director General, Department of Fisheries attended the function as special guests.

Dr Abdur Razzaque, Coordinator, National Farming Systems Research and Development Programme and Dr Md Fazul Haque, CSO, BARC also spoke on the occasion.

Metropolitan courts to start functioning in 3 months : Khasru

Law Minister Abdul Matin Khasru Thursday said proposed Metropolitan Sessions Courts in Dhaka and Chittagong cities will start functioning within next three months, reports UNB.

The Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has already approved a proposal to set up Metropolitan Sessions Courts in Dhaka and Chittagong, he told a discussion meeting organised by the Metropolitan Bar Association in the city.

The Law Minister said "Metropolitan courts would not only reduce pressure on the Traditional District Sessions Courts but it would also help ensure law and order in the metropolitan cities through speedy disposal of criminal cases."

The proposed courts will temporarily sit in the District Court premises of the two metropolitan cities and in near future, the courts will be shifted to suitable places, Khasru said.

The meeting was presided over by Metropolitan Bar Association President Alhaj Fazlur Rahman. It was addressed among others by Chief Metropolitan Magistrate A K Shamsul Haq.
