Compel Occidental to conduct EIA prior to any exploration work : FEJB

Chairman of Forum of Environmental Journalists of Bangladesh (FEJB) Quamrul Islam Chowdhury and General Secretary Bakhtier Rana yesterday expressed concern over the news of drilling of another exploratory well at Jalalabad by Occidental company without proper clearance from the Department of Environment, Reports BSS.

They pointed out that in proper Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and reluctance to prepare a contingency plan by the same company led to the devastating explosion in Magurchara in June last year damaging the surrounding ecosystem, rain forest and scarce natural resources.

They called upon the government to strictly follow the existing law of the land and compel the exploration companies to conduct EIA and take contingency plan prior to any exploration activities for averting tragic natural catastrophes in the future and preserving country's scarce natural resources and eco-systems.

The FEJB leaders reminded the concerned officials of the probable tragic consequences of such defiance of existing law which requires every company to conduct EIA and take contingency plan prior to clearance from the department of environment in such cases.

They also urged the concerned authorities to check such defiance of law for averting any future tragic accidents like Magurchara in Bangladesh again.

Another report adds: Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers Association (BELA) yesterday expressed its deep concern over the news published in a section of newspapers about the drilling of a new exploratory well in Jalalabad by the Occidental of Bangladesh Ltd without obtaining clearance from the Department of Environment (DOE), an association press release said last night.

NSU responds to newspaper reports about private universities

Dr Enamul Huq to be awarded D Sc honoris causa

The Academic Committee of the Open University of Alternative Medicines of India has decided to confer on Dr Enamul Huque, Founder Director General (Retired) of the Bangladesh National Museum "D.Sc. Honoris Causa" for his "unique contribution towards the museum movement in Bangladesh and researches on the invaluable art of Bengal". The degree will be conferred on February 8 at the Convocation on the occasion of the 5th International Congress of Alternative Medicines being held in Calcutta, says a press release.

Dr Huque had his Honours and Masters degree in history from Dhaka University, Doctorate in South Asian Art from Oxford and Post-Graduate Diploma-in-Museology from London.

Earlier, he was elected a honorary international councillor of the Asia Society of New York (1986-92), awarded "Ramaprasad Chanda Centenary Medal" by the Asiatic Society of Calcutta (1993) and Bangladesh Shishu Academy Agrani Bank Literary Award (1986).

He was also elected as the President of the International Council of Museums Asia-Pacific Organisation (1983-86).

Currently, he is Professor of National Culture and Heritage in the Independent University, Bangladesh, and the President of the International Centre for Study of Bengal Art.

BMGEA hails ban on trade union activities in Bangladesh Bank

Bangladesh Garments Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA) yesterday hailed the government's decision to ban trade union activities in Bangladesh Bank, reports BSS.

In a statement, President of BGMEA Mustafa Golam Quddus also urged the government to stop all kinds of trade union activities at the Chittagong Port to help pave shipments of the export-oriented industrial sectors which earns 66 per cent foreign currencies for the country.

Quddus said that BGMEA considers the government's decision as appropriate and significant.
